He also stated that per the new federal mandate that took place on January 1st, 2014 all brass fittings used in the repair of the meter that is a pipe, pipe fitting, plumbing fitting, or fixture must meet the new definition of lead free and that would mean replacing everything that is currently on the shelf.

COMMITTEE REPORTS:

President Betcher stated that the personnel committee met and would like to recommend the following changes to DPW Employee Compensation:

DPW would no longer receive paid overtime or double time for coming in on Saturday and Sunday to check the water/sewer systems, instead they will be compensated in their hourly rate and will leave 4 hours early on Fridays and will receive 8 comp days every 12 months.

Kermit Woidan will receive a .50 cent raise retroactive to October 1st, 2014 for taking on more responsibility and with the added compensation for on call status in the amount of .38 would bring his total compensation to 13.88 per hour.

James Heacock would also be responsible for 20% cost sharing of his health insurance premium but will be compensated for that 20% in his hourly rate of \$1.06 and also for on call status will be compensated an additional .41. This will bring his total compensation to 15.70 per hour
