From The Board:

Committee Opportunities: The Board of Directors is seeking to enlarge the number of committees to involve more residents in the Community's activities. New proposed committees include Landscape, Capital Improvements (includes tennis courts), Clubhouse & Pool, Communications, and Finance. Current committees include the Social headed by Brittany Milward and Laura Payne, Security headed by John Kennelly, and Architectural Control headed by Dean Barnes. Political Yard Signs Reminder: Political signs for the upcoming election on November 5, can be posted from August 7 through November 17. (In compliance with Texas Property Code, Section 202.009(a) and our deed restrictions (Article 15).)

Kirkwood Lift Station Diversion and Abandonment update: The City of Houston is planning to abandon the existing sanitary sewer lift station on the east side of Kirkwood, south of the Buffalo Bayou Bridge. Construction bids have been received. The award of the construction contract will be on the Council agenda in July. The construction start is anticipated in early September.

Kirkwood Paving and Drainage Project: This project will reconstruct Kirkwood Road from Buffalo Bayou to Westheimer Road in two projects, and add substantial in-line detention underneath the new roadway. The first project goes from Buffalo Bayou including the Briar Forest intersection. Mayor Turner announced at the Briar Forest Super Neighborhood meeting on June 18th, that the construction will start in the first quarter of 2020.

Super Neighborhood 18: Country Village is part of Super Neighborhood 18. There is a monthly meeting on the third Tuesday of the month. The meeting is held at the Briarwood School at 12207 Whittington Dr. The meeting is open to all residents. At the meeting of June 18th, new officers were elected; Alexis Kiker, President. The next meeting is on September 17th from 6:30-8:00
