

LETTER OF WRITTEN AUTHORITY OF THE COUNCIL OF THE BOROUGH OF SOUTH TYNESIDE IN ITS CAPACITY AS ADMINISTERING AUTHORITY OF THE TYNE AND WEAR PENSION FUND ("THE LANDOWNER") – CORPORATION STREET, PRESTON ("THE SITE")

ParkingEye Ltd requires this authority in order to issue parking charges at the Site. It is not a contract; it simply enables ParkingEye Ltd to meet its compliance requirements with regards the POPLA assessments and to enable ParkingEye Ltd to continue to offer car park management services at the Site until such time that a contract is in place with the Landowner.

ParkingEye Ltd currently provides car park management, control and enforcement at Site.

At the Site, as an Approved Operator Scheme (AOS) member, ParkingEye Ltd needs confirmation of the authorisation given by the landowner in writing to enable ParkingEye Ltd to carry out enforceable parking management, control and enforcement on the Landowners private land.

Please confirm authorisation as follows:

- Where motorists park in a manner not authorised under the terms and conditions of parking as set out in the signage at the Site, subject to the agreed permit criteria and exemptions, in accordance with the terms and conditions, as aforementioned, the parking charges as agreed in the Site User Manual, "Parking Charges" may be issued on behalf of the Landowner to the motorist;
- The Landowner authorises ParkingEye Ltd to pursue the outstanding parking charges in accordance with the British Parking Association Approved Operator Scheme Code of Practice.
