Tax Advantage Giving IRA Qualified Charitable Distributions

This allows individuals over 70½ years old to donate up to \$100,000 in IRA assets directly to charity annually, without taking the distribution into taxable income.

You MUST have your IRA institution transfer the funds from your account **DIRECTLY** to the charity. If you have it sent to you first it is taxable income.

Ask your accountant for the details and how to qualify.
