[REDACTED] also accuses [REDACTED] of not completing a report in a timely manor.

I spoke with [REDACTED] and witness [REDACTED] about these allegations. I also interviewed Officer [REDACTED] in accordance with the Police Officer Bill Of Rights. After completing my investigation I determined that Officer [REDACTED] was not in violation of any Lincoln Police Department rules or regulations.

The charge of False Statements PD-5100-B-6 was determined to be ( Unfounded )

The charge of completing reports in a timely manner PD-5100-G-7 was ( Not Sustained )

I advised [REDACTED] of my findings. I gave Officer [REDACTED] a copy of my findings.

On 9/24/13 I interviewed [REDACTED] in regards to an incident involving Officer [REDACTED]. I tape recorded this interview. [REDACTED] explained that [REDACTED] was texting her asking her to meet him after her doctors appointment on September 19, 2013 at 7pm. [REDACTED] asked [REDACTED] to meet up with his at the Lincoln Mall Parking lot. [REDACTED] states she did meet him, thinking there was something wrong with him, or his family.

[REDACTED] states once she met [REDACTED] at the mall she entered his truck to talk with him. She states that is when [REDACTED] began making unwanted comments to her about his feeling towards her. [REDACTED] states [REDACTED] twice touched or grabbed her arm, both time she told him not to touch her.

[REDACTED] states she exited [REDACTED] truck and entered her car. [REDACTED] tried to lean into her car trying to kiss her good by. [REDACTED] again told [REDACTED] to stop. [REDACTED] stopped but told [REDACTED] to text him later or he would call her cell phone all night. [REDACTED] then drove off.

[REDACTED] states that [REDACTED] continued to send her unwanted text messages that night and the next morning. [REDACTED] saved all the text in question. [REDACTED] down loaded all texts sent by [REDACTED]

[REDACTED] informed [REDACTED] of the Town of Lincoln Harassment Policy. I had [REDACTED] give me a formal statement (SEE STATEMENT FOR MORE INFO) and advised her to take her complaint to the [REDACTED] for investigation.

On November 6th [REDACTED] came to me with a complaint that [REDACTED] was rude and unprofessional towards her while she worked in the Police Dispatch area. [REDACTED] gave me a full account of what transpired and stated that [REDACTED] also witnessed [REDACTED] unprofessionalism towards [REDACTED]. I then had Dispatcher [REDACTED] give me a formal statement on what she witnessed that day. (See statement for more info)

After conducting my investigation I agree that Officer [REDACTED] did intentionally act unprofessional towards [REDACTED] while she worked [REDACTED]. Officer [REDACTED] violated Lincoln Police Rules Of Conduct policy #PD-5100.

[REDACTED] advised [REDACTED] of my findings. Officer [REDACTED] was spoken to about this incident and given two suspension days for violating department policy. Officer [REDACTED] excepted this punishment and assured the [REDACTED] that this will not occur again.

On 5-27-14 [REDACTED] informed me that a town citizen [REDACTED] reached out to him with a complaint about Lincoln Police Officer [REDACTED] [REDACTED] informed [REDACTED] and I that [REDACTED] informed him Officer [REDACTED] has been having sex with [REDACTED] wife, [REDACTED]. Mr. [REDACTED] states Officer [REDACTED] is on Duty when many of these sex events occurs.

[REDACTED] and I contacted [REDACTED] and set up a meeting with him and his wife [REDACTED]. We met with [REDACTED] and [REDACTED] on [REDACTED] at 09:00 at the Lincoln Senior Center to further investigate this allegation. [REDACTED] asked if her husband could stay with her during our interview. We then interviewed both parties in a private room at the Senior Center.

At the beginning of the interview [REDACTED] explained to both [REDACTED] that this interview will be recorded. Both agreed. During this interview [REDACTED] explained that she has been having sex with [REDACTED] for the past two years, and she will meet [REDACTED] while he is on duty as a Lincoln Police Officer and have him oral sex. [REDACTED] states this has occurred many times at several meeting spots in Lincoln.

[REDACTED] states she initially like meeting Officer [REDACTED] for sex. [REDACTED] states she would often send [REDACTED] naked pictures of herself. [REDACTED] states she tried to break off the affair with [REDACTED] but he constantly follows her, parks his police car in front of her home located at [REDACTED]. [REDACTED] states Officer [REDACTED] also told her he has all her naked pictures on a thumb drive secured in his police locker. [REDACTED] states she is afraid of her pictures getting out into the public so she continues to meet Officer [REDACTED] to give him "Blow Jobs". [REDACTED] states Officer [REDACTED] never threatened her with releasing the pictures if she did not provide sex for him, she just assumed that is what would occur.

[REDACTED] and I then took our recorded interview to the AG Office to have the facts reviewed to see if there is anything criminal with Officer [REDACTED] actions. Lieutenant [REDACTED] and I were advised by [REDACTED] that with the present facts this matter is not criminal. I then advised [REDACTED] and [REDACTED] of the A.G's findings.

[REDACTED] was assigned to assist me investigating this complaint further.

[REDACTED] was advised by [REDACTED] that on [REDACTED] [REDACTED] was going to carry a recording device and meet [REDACTED] at St James Cemetery. [REDACTED] and I meet [REDACTED] at the St James cemetery [REDACTED] at approximately 07:30 hours. [REDACTED] contacted Officer [REDACTED] asking him to meet her at [REDACTED]. [REDACTED] arrived at the cemetery a short time later.

[REDACTED] and I were in a wooded area directly behind the grave stone that had "Rose" on it. Shortly after 08:00 [REDACTED] pulled into the cemetery in a marked police car to speak with [REDACTED]. During this recorded conversation Officer [REDACTED] admits to having sex with [REDACTED] on duty. ( review recording for complete conversation ).

On 10-17-14, I responded to Officer [REDACTED] house and hand delivered his Suspension Letter to him. [REDACTED] stated he understood and accepted the letter. A copy of this letter was placed in the case folder.

On 11-5-14 Officer [REDACTED] resigned from the Lincoln Police Department ending this investigation. \*\*\*

On 3-15-15 [REDACTED] into HQ to file a Citizen Complaint against Officer [REDACTED]. [REDACTED] explains he believes Officer [REDACTED] followed him for miles and ticket him for speeding without cause, ( See Complaint form for more information ).

3-15 I interviewed Officer [REDACTED] about this complaint. Officer [REDACTED] advised me he was in cruiser car 501 conducting Radar on Main St in Albion when a vehicle ( RI REG [REDACTED] ) driven by [REDACTED] was on radar traveling 40 MPH in a 25 MPH zone. [REDACTED] states he pulled out behind [REDACTED] vehicle and waited for safe location to conduct a car stop. [REDACTED] pulled into a driveway on [REDACTED] St and remained in his vehicle. [REDACTED] states he waited to see if [REDACTED] was going to pull out onto [REDACTED] St again so [REDACTED] could conduct a I/V stop.

Officer [REDACTED] states [REDACTED] exited his vehicle before he could conduct his car stop. Officer [REDACTED] then pulled [REDACTED] and told [REDACTED] to get back into his vehicle so he could write him a ticket for speeding. [REDACTED] was uncooperative and attempted to go into an apartment. Officer [REDACTED] told him if he did not stay with his vehicle it would be towed. [REDACTED] states [REDACTED] continue to be uncooperative and was recording the incident with his cell phone. Officer [REDACTED] then issued Summons # [REDACTED] for no license on person and speeding.

Interviewed [REDACTED] and he advised me that Officer [REDACTED] informed him that [REDACTED] was stopped for speeding and that [REDACTED] was being uncooperative. [REDACTED] states Officer [REDACTED] acted professional the entire time he was there.

On 5-21-14 [redacted] forwarded me a formal complaint made by a [redacted] against [redacted]. [redacted] compliant alleges, [redacted] ( [redacted] assaulted her during an investigation [redacted] [redacted] was subsequently arrested during this incident by [redacted]

On 5-29-14 I mailed [redacted] a letter advising her this complaint will be investigated.

On 6-30-14 I contacted [redacted], a witness at the time this accident occurred. [redacted] explained that she did not witness any Lincoln Police Officer do anything wrong during the entire time she was at his M/V accident.

[redacted] stated she was contacted by [redacted] by text message. In this text message [redacted] texted that she did not remember much of the accident due to a [redacted] she sustained during the accident. [redacted] forwarded me these text messages in question. All text message were added to case folder ( See Text or more info ).

On [redacted] I interviewed [redacted] about this complaint. [redacted] explained that [redacted] was combative and swearing at him the entire time. [redacted] states he arrested a passenger, [redacted] [redacted] states he issued [redacted] a RIT Summons # [redacted] for having no proof of insurance. [redacted] refused to sign the ticket and continued to yell and swear at him. [redacted] states he offered [redacted] a ride from the scene and she began to kick and punch his patrol car 507.

[redacted] states due to [redacted] action traffic was backing up causing a larger traffic issue. [redacted] advises [redacted] that she was under arrest. [redacted] states [redacted] told him " Fuck You your not respecting me ". [redacted] attempts to grab [redacted] right arm to take custody of her and she pulled her arm away. [redacted] continued to use verbal commands and took [redacted] to the ground placing her under arrest Disorderly Conduct and Resisting Arrest. [redacted] states he successfully cuffed [redacted] and double locked cuffs for her protection. [redacted] was searched and secured in police car 503. [redacted] states only at end of effecting this arrest did [redacted] assist to help lift [redacted] to her feet.

At HQ, [redacted] continued to yell and [redacted] the Detention Room door. [redacted] was slamming the door in the detention room. [redacted] states [redacted] was very aggressive and her hand cuffs were left on for safety reasons. Once it was determined that [redacted] could not calm herself down a rescue was called to HQ for an evaluation and eventual transport to the hospital.

[redacted] states at no time did [redacted] strike or assault [redacted]. The only time [redacted] touched [redacted] was to assist lifting her to her feet.

On 7-1-14 I interviewed [redacted]. [redacted] explained that he was with [redacted] they both witnessed [redacted] fighting with [redacted]. [redacted] states he heard [redacted] give verbal commands to [redacted], these commands were " Stop resisting". [redacted] states he saw [redacted] take [redacted] to the ground by her arm. [redacted] states he and [redacted] assisted [redacted] lifting [redacted] to her feet and securing her in police car 503. On [redacted] [redacted] states that was the only time he touched [redacted]

[REDACTED] on scene. [REDACTED] gave me a similar account of [REDACTED] being combative and using abusive language towards [REDACTED].

On 7-7-14 I interviewed [REDACTED] ([REDACTED]). [REDACTED] stated he and [REDACTED] saw [REDACTED] take [REDACTED] to the ground by using an arm bar take down. [REDACTED] states he heard [REDACTED] giving verbal commands to [REDACTED] for her to stop resisting. [REDACTED] states he is certain the only time [REDACTED] touched [REDACTED] on scene was to assist [REDACTED] with lifting [REDACTED] to her feet to secure her in car 503. Officer [REDACTED] also confirms [REDACTED] combative behavior the entire time on scene and at HQ.

[REDACTED] reviewed [REDACTED] Use Of force Report, and [REDACTED] review of [REDACTED] Use Of Force Report.

After reviewing and investigating all known facts surrounding this complaint I find that All 3 Officers, [REDACTED] acted in accordance with our department Rules and regulations.

The allegation of a Assault charge, and Profanity against Officer involved during this incident are Unfounded.

[REDACTED] states on Friday [REDACTED] he was advised that [REDACTED]'s truck, ([REDACTED]) was struck while parked in the secured area of the highway parking lot. The truck in question is owned by [REDACTED] but is driven on a daily basis by highway worker [REDACTED]. [REDACTED] is making payments on the truck and he will eventually receive ownership. [REDACTED] states he questioned all his workers about this accident. [REDACTED] states [REDACTED] admitted he moved some highway trucks, but [REDACTED] does not remember, and does not believe, he moved the truck that caused the damage to [REDACTED]'s truck. At this point [REDACTED] informed [REDACTED] of this incident.

[REDACTED] states on Monday August 31st [REDACTED] called him to tell him the Town of Lincoln should pay for the damage to [REDACTED] truck due to the truck being parked in a secured area with only town workers and town vehicles in that secured area. Shortly after, [REDACTED] responded to the highway garage and [REDACTED] informed [REDACTED] to list [REDACTED] as the operator and the town will pay for the damage. [REDACTED] takes the information given and leaves without questioning [REDACTED]. [REDACTED] later adds [REDACTED] to the accident report as the operator.

[REDACTED] in states on 9-3-15 he received a call from [REDACTED] explained he just received a state accident report in the mail with him listed as the operator of the town vehicle involved in the accident. [REDACTED] tells [REDACTED] that this information is incorrect that he was not the operator. [REDACTED] tells [REDACTED] he will take care of this issue.

9-8-15 [REDACTED] advised [REDACTED] about the issue and [REDACTED] called [REDACTED] to request [REDACTED] be removed from the accident report. [REDACTED] removed [REDACTED] name from the report.

10-21-15 I spoke with [REDACTED] regarding this investigation. [REDACTED] gave me a similar account of what transpired during his initial accident investigation. [REDACTED] stated he now understands that he should not have listed [REDACTED] as the operator of the town vehicle that caused the damage to [REDACTED] truck without questioning [REDACTED]. [REDACTED] assured me he will never make this type of mistake again.

[REDACTED] and [REDACTED] complete a more detailed incident report on this matter ( Report # [REDACTED]).

While investigating this incident, I determined [REDACTED] did not intentionally attempt to mislead anyone regarding who truly operated the town vehicle in question. [REDACTED] was acting on information he believed was investigated and vetted out by the [REDACTED] Foreman [REDACTED]. [REDACTED] realized his error and promised me this type of mistake will never happen again.

On 1-2-15 Lt / [REDACTED] advised me that [REDACTED] responded to HQ to complain about Officer [REDACTED] actions during a M/V stop that occurred on 12-28-15 on Higginson Ave. [REDACTED] states Officer [REDACTED] stopped him for speeding but refused to tell him why he stopped him. [REDACTED] stated he asked Officer [REDACTED] four times before Officer [REDACTED] finally answered him on why he was stopped.

[REDACTED] also complained that Officer [REDACTED] told him he was traveling 12 mph over the posted speed limit of 25 mph, yet the ticket issued reads 36 mph in a 25 mph zone.

On 12-28-15 [REDACTED] spoke with Officer [REDACTED] about this complaint. ( See Memo )

On 1-13-16 I interviewed Officer [REDACTED] about this Civilian Complaint. Officer [REDACTED] states he always explains to motorists why he stopped them as soon as he approaches their vehicle; however this car stop was different due to the operator [REDACTED] exiting his vehicle and giving Officer [REDACTED] a hard time about getting back in the car. Officer [REDACTED] states as soon as he gained control of the scene by having [REDACTED] calm down and sit back in his car, [REDACTED] explained to [REDACTED] why he stopped him.

Officer [REDACTED] denied ever telling [REDACTED] that he was traveling 12 mph over the speed limit.

After reviewing this complaint I believe Officer [REDACTED] actions were reasonable and no Lincoln Police policies were violated.
