On 1-2-15 Lt / advised me that about Officer actions during a M/V stop that occurred on 12-28-15 on Higginson Ave.

states Officer stopped him for speeding but refused to tell him why he stopped him. stated he asked Officer four times before Officer finally answered him on why he was stopped.

also complained that Officer told him he was traveling 12 mph over the posted speed limit of 25 mph, yet the ticket issued reads 36 mph in a 25 mph zone.

On 12-28-15 poke with Officer books bout this complaint. (See Memo)

On 1-13-16 I interviewed Officer about this Civilian Complaint. Officer states he always explains to motorists why he stopped them as soon as he approaches their vehicle: however this car stop was different due to the operator exiting his vehicle and giving Officer a hard time about getting back in the car. Officer states as soon as he gained control of the scene by having and sit back in his car, explained to why he stopped him.

Office denied ever telling that he was traveling 12 mph over the speed limit.

After reviewing this complaint I believe Officer actions were reasonable and no Lincoln Police policies were violated.
