

ORDINANCE NO: 25-1248

AN ORDINANCE ESTABLISHING THE POSITION OF INTERIM VILLAGE ADMINISTRATOR, APPOINTING AN INTERIM VILLAGE ADMINISTRATOR, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the Village of Russells Point, Ohio:

WHEREAS, the Village Council created the position of Village Administration in Ordinance Number

WHEREAS, the Village of Russells Point wishes to appoint an interim Village Administrator to serve in the role of Village Administrator until a permanent Village Administrator can be appointed;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED, by the Council of the Village of Russells Point, Ohio:

SECTION 1

A. APPOINTMENT OF INTERIM VILLAGE ADMINISTRATOR

- (a) Pursuant to the foregoing, the Village Mayor and Council hereby authorize the creation and appointment of an Interim Village Administrator to serve until the appointment of a permanent Village Administrator as set forth in Ordinance Number The _____. Interim Village Administrator shall have all powers, duties, and authority as set forth herein for the position of Village Administrator in Ordinance Number_____.
- (b) The Interim Village Administrator shall serve until the position of Village Administrator is filled.
- (c) The Interim Village Administrator shall be_____.
- (d) The Interim Village Administrator position shall be at will and the Interim Village Administrator shall serve at the discretion of the Mayor and Village Council of the Village of Russells Point.
- (e) The Interim Village Administrator may be removed without cause by the concurrence of the Mayor and a majority of the Village Council.
- (f) The Interim Village Administrator may be removed without cause without the

consent of the Mayor by a vote of a 2/3rds majority of the Village Council.

- (g) The Interim Village Administrator's compensation shall be _____
- (h) The Interim Village Administrator shall not serve for more than six (6) months from the effective date of this Ordinance.


SECTION 111:

That it is found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the adoption of this Ordinance were adopted in an open meeting of this council and that all deliberations of this Council, and any of its committees that resulted in such formal action, were in meetings open to the public in compliance with all legal requirements of the Ohio Revised Code.


SECTION IV:

This Ordinance is hereby found to be an emergency necessary for the public welfare because the Village administration requires uninterrupted leadership for ongoing and future matters to provide the services necessary to the general public health, safety, and welfare. Further, the appointment of an interim Village Administrator is deemed to be an emergency in order to safeguard the general public health, safety, and welfare, and to allow the benefit of a Village Administrator during the time period in which the Village Council can review qualifications and make a final appointment. This Ordinance shall take effect and be in full force immediately upon passage.
