- Specimens will be judged on quality and uniformity (if more than on item is required).
- All entries must be fresh not frozen.
- Entries should be free of dirt, cuts, bruises and defects as well as insect or disease free. No waxes or oils may be used.
- Trim tops only where indicated and to the length stated. Do not overscrub vegetables. Clean using a soft cloth and wash gently.

- Display exhibits on a foam or plastic plate (NO paper plates). Do not cover.
- Not responsible for accidents or lost items.
- All entries will be on display until 5:00 p.m. **Projects are to be picked up at 5:00 p.m.** Exhibitors unable to pick up exhibits should make alternate arrangements. **The shelter house must be emptied by 5:30 p.m.** Any unclaimed entries will be discarded.
- **Premium checks may be picked up at the fair office on Saturday, July 20, after 6:00 p.m. If you can not make it at this time please make other arrangements.** If you would like your check mailed, you must bring a self-addressed stamped envelope to the Fair Office the day of your event.

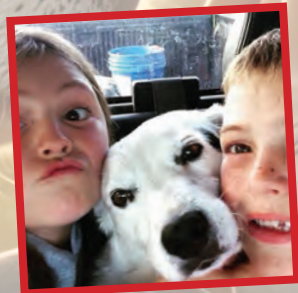
