DESCRIPTION: Here is a really nice enhanced Shakespeare Sierra. Even though the Sierra was a mid-entry bow, this one performs as well as the higher-end Shakespeare bows, which were among the best shooting bows ever made. Imbuja riser. Tip overlays have been added for beauty and strength (for fast flight string capability). Bow has no delamination; no cracks; limbs are straight. Beveled arrow shelf. Overlays and tips are in great condition. No drilled holes; 1 small professionally filled screw hole on the back that is barely visible (see pic on last page). No chips, dings or cracks. No stress lines or crazing. A few minor scratches and nicks here and there. One larger filled scratch under the decal (see pic). Decals are in excellent minty condition.
