AFAP SCHOLARSHIP BOARD

This scholarship Board is hosted by AFAB DEVELOPMENT ASSOCIATION (ADA) at the national and international level and is charged with the mission of programming and awarding of annual scholarships to meritorious pupils and students of Afap origin. The following categories of scholarship shall be managed by the board:

CATEGORY ONE: SCHOLARSHIP AWARD TO THE LESS PRIVILEGED

This scholarship shall be awarded to less privileged pupils and students resident in Afap. Beneficiaries in this category fall under three classes:

- a) Physically challenged persons.
- b) Orphans from very poor background.
- c) Children whose parents are either physically challenged or have been rendered morbid (unproductive) as a result of either protracted illness or accident.

CATEGORY TWO: COMMON ENTRANCE AWARD

This scholarship is awarded to outstanding pupils of the Government Common Entrance Examination, and to special need pupils that have successfully completed class six and were able to distinguish themselves.

CATEGORY THREE: EXCELLENCE AWARD

This award is for students pursuing general and technical education with extraordinary performance in the following areas:

- GCE General Ordinary Level,
- GCE General Advanced Level,
- GCE Technical Ordinary Level,
- GCE Technical Advanced Level,
- Baccalaureate Technique.

This award shall be highly competitive, due to the limited resources available and the fact that many students shall be applying. Only meritorious students who distinguish themselves shall benefit from it.

CATEGORY FOUR: UNIVERSITY STUDENTS' AWARD

This award is for university students pursuing the Bachelors, Masters and Doctorate degree programs in any university in Cameroon.

Eligibility:

It shall be given to meritorious students with **GPA** of at least 3.0 on 4 for both undergraduate and graduate students.

At the beginning of every academic year, available scholarships shall be advertised by the scholarship Board both in and out of the country.

Application Requirements

Interested persons applying for any of the above mentioned categories of scholarship should provide the following:

- A hand written or typed application addressed to Afap Scholarship Board, ADA General, Cameroon.
- 2. A photocopy of result.
- 3. A photocopy of birth certificate.

Deadline for the receipt of documents shall be announced by the Board.

Afap Scholarship Board welcomes scholarship offers both in cash and in kind from actual and potential benefactors notably; ADA members in and out of the country, charity organizations and persons involved in humanitarian work.
