# Carried to the Table September 2017 Sermon Series

Carried to the Table, the song by LEELAND, has become a familiar favorite to JRCC. For many weeks, it is the song that has played during our communion worship every Sunday. Do you know the real life, biblical story that it is based upon? It is a story of friendship, adoption, God's calling, neglect, abuse, and even death.

### 3 Relationships 1 Sam 18:1-4

We first meet Jonathan after the young shepherd boy David defeats the giant Goliath, winning a massive (get it?) victory for God and his people. David's reward? He's not allowed to go home; King Saul wants him close by. The prince, Jonathan has now met his best friend, and in doing so teaches us the power of friendship that is more like family than anything else.

#### 10 Interceding 1 Sam 19:1-7

Know anyone that has a parent that is nice one minute, then (the moment something doesn't go their way) explodes into a fit of rage? That's a perfect way to describe Jonathan's dad, King Saul, who decides he's so angry at David he puts out the call to have him killed. Ever have to choose between a parent and a friend? In doing so, Jonathan teaches us what Jesus does for us every day - intercedes.

### 17 Choosing Sides (abuse) 1 Sam 20

Saul's rage against David comes and goes, to the point that Jonathan chooses David over his dad. Dad's rage now, though, is centered squarely on his son. Those of us that have suffered abuse at the hands of loved ones will not forget the truths we will discover in the Bible on this emotional Sunday in September.

### 24 Death 1 Sam 28

Saul has completely unraveled, to the point that God has taken the Holy Spirit away from him. So, Saul does what anyone else would do - hires a medium to talk to the dead. (Whaaaa?) In the end, it will cost him his life...and the life of his son. How do we react to parents that have turned away from God, before it affects us as well?



Youth Group is starting up again and we have several new members coming up this year. First meeting of this school year is September 9<sup>th</sup> at noon. We will meet at the church that day and plan out the coming year. I will have meeting times and dates through the end of the calendar year.
