- 1. Exhibitors will be expected to display or parade their animals as directed by the Superintendent; to accept the stall assigned without controversy; to keep their animals in an attractive appearance and to cooperate with the Department in every way that may serve to increase the educational value of the show.
- 2. Exhibitors of livestock must inform themselves as to when their stock will be judged. Stock must be in the ring promptly on call and a failure to comply with the order renders exhibitors liable to be ruled out of competing.
- 3. Decorations with ribbons or ornaments previously won by the animals at shows shall be prohibited until after the awards have been made in their respective classes by the judge.
- 4. Exhibitors must have all animals for competition on the grounds to later than Monday 12 noon.
