**D**istracted driving continues to be an ever growing danger on our State's roadway. Although several local ordinances and a state law prohibiting teens from texting and driving for the first 6 months of driving have been passed, more needs to be done!

The Arizona Distracted Driving Summit brings together citizens, law enforcement agencies, legislators & elected officials, as well as numerous other state and national organizations to focus on how we can reduce and eliminate the growing crisis of distracted driving in our communities and on our roadways.

The continuing theme of the Summit as in previous years will focus on three major areas: Education, Enforcement, & Engagement.

The 2019 Summit will facilitate group discussions and presentations following a morning introduction and key note speaker. The lunch key note may include a special guest or a panel discussions focused on education. A closing panel discussion will focus on engagement and cooperation between citizens and governmental officials. Educational sessions will enable attendees to earn continuing education credits (CEU'S) for their professional certifications.

A simulated vehicle/pedestrian collision and emergency rescue/recovery is being proposed to take place on the city street adjacent to the Capital from 11:00AM- 11:30AM. Event details will be made available for all sessions and activities in November 2018.
