- Antique car parade down Main Street New London at 5:30 pm followed by community chicken & rib buffet at the Legion

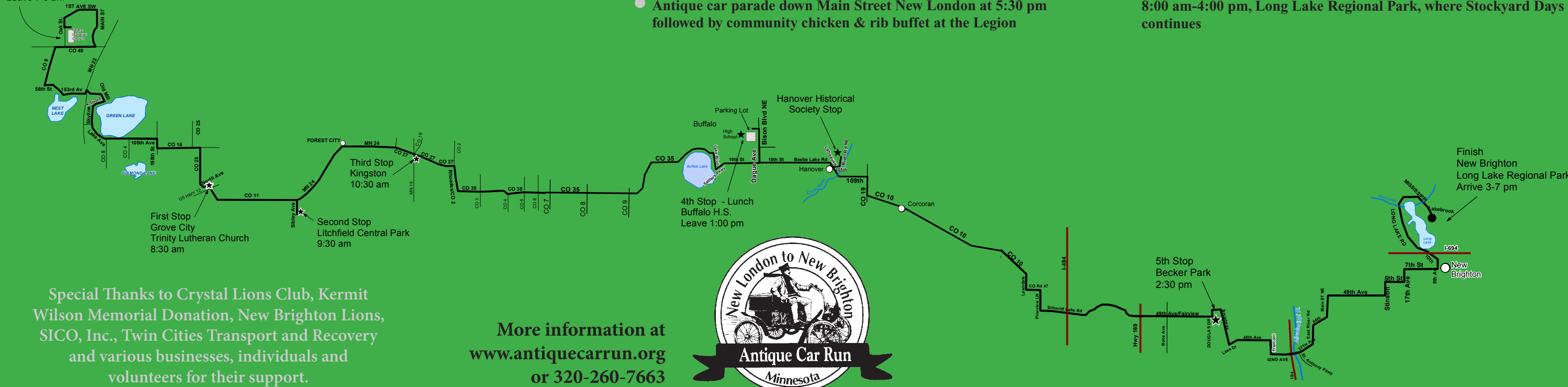
Saturday, August 11
