Dear Dorper & White Dorper Exhibitor and/or Breeder,

The Chisholm Trail Dorper Association (CTDA) is hosting its 4th annual futurity ewe sale, youth show & educational event on June 19th & 20th in Cameron, TX. Friday there will be activities for the youth including educational opportunities (fitting, feeding, etc) and showmanship clinics. Saturday we will have the production class followed by the Futurity ewe sale (11am) and youth show (1pm). **New for this year the barn will be open Thursday for animals to arrive! Huge thanks to ADSBS for their sponsorship of the educational event this year!!!!!!!!!!**

General Sale Guidelines

We will begin to receive sale sheep on Friday, June 19th at 2pm (if you have a youth attending the event you can bring your sheep as early as Thursday evening). All consignments must be in their stalls by Saturday morning at 9am. The sale will start at 11am. **To secure your entries return the entry form with a \$50 per head deposit. The check will be returned at the sale, and only cashed if consignor fails to bring the entered sheep.** A 10% commission will be charged to the seller on all lots. There will be a floor price of \$400 on all ewes. You are responsible for all PO's.

Futurity Ewe Sale – Saturday, June 20th 11am

Each consignor is limited to three (3) individual entries per ranch, the association reserves the right to limit the entries if too many are received. To consign a futurity lamb in the sale, you must be a member of the Chisholm Trail Youth Dorper Association – Breeder Sponsor (CTYDA) as well as a member in good standing with the ADSBS. All futurity ewes must already be registered with the ADSBS. **All futurity ewes must have papers at the time of check in to be qualified for the sale. They will also go through a sifting committee to ensure there are no cull faults or sub-standard quality.** All decisions of this committee are final and cannot be appealed. Culled sheep will not be allowed to sale. **There is a \$35 nomination fee due to the “ADSBS” for all ewes nominated. This will need to be paid prior to the sale.** Ewe lambs must be born between September 2019 – April 2020. **Shavings will not be provided but may be brought by the consignor.**

Youth Educational Events & Showmanship Clinic – Friday, June 19th 8:00am

Friday evening following the youth educational events there will be a showmanship clinic. The showmanship clinic will be divided up by age: Pee Wee , Junior , Intermediate & senior. There will be no cost for this event if a member of the association. Also, there will be a special event for the adults (judged by the kids) “Old Timers Show”. Any purebred or fullblood registered Dorper or white Dorper regardless of the owner can be shown.

Breeding Dorper Show General Guidelines - Saturday, June 20th 1pm

The youth breeding sheep show will follow the futurity sale on Saturday the 20th (11 am). Entries fees for the youth show will be \$25 per entry. Payment and entry forms are due June 1st, but sheep that are purchased through the sale will be allowed to enter that day. Late entries will not be accepted.

All entries in the Youth Breeding Show must be registered in the youth’s name and the youth must be a member of the American Dorper Sheep Breeder’s Society (membership and dues can be paid at the event) & CTYDA. Sheep purchased during the sale may be entered in the show. The purchase receipt will show proof of ownership. We will have enough pens for those sheep that are entered by June 1st.

A complete list of the classes offered is available in the “Youth Sheep Show” handout.

Youth Sheep Production – Saturday 9am

The goal of this division is to showcase the production of Dorper females and their offspring. Producers appreciate traits such as excellent daily gains, early maturing, fertility and feed efficiency. A record book of production, daily gains from birth to show date and associated costs to produce each animal will be kept and turned into the show secretary by 4pm June 19th, 2020 for judging before the live show and interview.

Breeding sheep classes: Separate divisions for Dorper and White Dorper

- 1) Aged Ram (born on or before Aug 31, 2018; carrying all teeth)
- 2) Yearling Ram (born Sept 1, 2018 to Aug 31, 2019)
- 3) Fall Ram Lamb (Sept 1, 2019 to Dec 30, 2019)
- 4) Spring Ram Lamb (Jan 1, 2020 to April 30, 2020) will be broken down further if there are enough entries
- 5) Pair of Rams
- 6) Champion & Reserve Champion Rams
- 7) Aged Ewe (born on or before Aug 31, 2018; carrying all teeth)
- 8) Yearling Ewe (born Sept 1, 2018 to Aug 31, 2019)
- 9) Fall Ewe Lamb (born Sept 1, 2019 to Nov 31, 2019)
- 10) Winter Ewe Lamb (born Dec 1, 2019 to Feb 28, 2020)
- 11) Spring Ewe Lamb (born Mar 1, 2020 to April 30, 2020)
- 12) Pair of Ewes
- 13) Champion & Reserve Champion Ewes
- 14) Best Pair (one ram and one ewe owned by same exhibitor, previously shown)
- 15) Flock - one ram (any age), 2 ewes (yearling or aged) and 2 ewe lambs (9/1/2019-4/30/2020)
- 16) Premier Exhibitor



Show Rules

- 1) All exhibitors must be ADSBS members in good standing (dues paid for 2020).
- 2) All sheep shown must be ADSBS registered in the name of the junior exhibitor (not in family or ranch name). Animals may be jointly owned by multiple junior exhibitors. Animals purchased in the 2020 CTDA Sale in the name of the junior exhibitor may be shown by post entry following the sale.
- 3) There is no minimum age for exhibitors, but the junior exhibitor must show their animal by controlling the head. Another junior exhibitor may assist in the ring as a heeler (set hind legs).
- 4) All sheep must be properly washed and sheared.
- 5) Sheep may be shown with or without halters in all classes.
- 6) Entry fee is \$25 per head on individual. Group classes and showmanship are free.
- 7) All youth show sheep must be penned and checked in by 9am, June 20th. Shavings will not be provided. All sheep must carry USDA scrapie identification tags.
- 8) Banners for champions and ribbons for classes will be awarded.
- 9) Premier exhibitor – This will be award based on a point system: 1st place – 5 points, 2nd place – 4 points, 3rd place – 3 points, 4th place – 2 points, 5th place – 1 point. No points will be given for champions or group classes. One overall premier exhibitor will be awarded per breed.
- 10) Sheep should be shown per the ADSBS Junior guidelines in regards in bracing.

Entry Deadline June 1st. No late entries will be accepted. Animals purchased through the youth sale will be able to enter at the regular entry price the day of the event.
