### Kingston Crescent

16 Jul 1965 New Police Station opened replacing Fratton Road and Kingston Cross 5(2)

### Kingston Road, Police Station

1897 Kingston Cross Police Station opened 5(2)

1904 Plot 36 foot frontage to Kingston Road, 137 feet deep bought for £648 95

### Ordnance Row, Police Station

1708 Cage erected on the Common 5(2)

1843 New police station to be built on site of existing cage 89

Stocks were left in front of station and removed after 1856 5(2)

1926 Old Station to be rented to PDSA 95

### Park Road

1931 Police stables converted to garage 5(2)

1949 Fire Station to be sold to Portsmouth & Gosport Gas Company for £9,500 95

### Portland Terrace

1946 Nos. 4,5,6,7,8,9 war damaged purchased by council to be renovated for Police housing, owner Edward Williams 95

1948 CPO agreed without modification 95

1948 [1700] 4-9 Portland Terrace, block of ten flats & police club for City of Portsmouth Corporation 95

### Queen's Crescent

Following bombing the Police Headquarters relocated to Byculla 5(2)

### St Michaels Road

Former St Michaels Vicarage used by A Division in 1941 9

Closed when Hyde Park Road station opened 9

### St Pauls Road

1953 Sites of Nos. 37, 39 & 41 St Pauls Road to be used for Police housing 95

**Copnor Fire Station**

1951	Proposed fire station	95
29 Apr 1957	Opened	
	Built as new headquarters for Portsmouth City Fire Brigade which was previously at Southsea	
	First Portsmouth Station where the firemen had to use the traditional pole as it was the first two storey station. The station included a drying chamber for the hoses, a 65 feet drill tower and transport workshops	
1 Oct 2008	Closed	
Feb 2012	Demolished
