Overlays and tips are in great condition. No drilled holes. No chips, dings or cracks. The only real flaw are stress lines on the face of the bow running from the grip to the end of the riser (see pics on p. 4). No stress lines in the working area of the limb. No crazing. A few scratches and scuffs here and there. Decal is in good shape. Overall, this is a serviceable field and hunting bow. This bow cost \$60 new in 1965, which would be \$491 in 2020 inflation-adjusted dollars.
