## **Director Report:**

- I. Referendum: To use resources more wisely, the library has decided not to do a direct mailing, but instead, utilize in-house marketing including bookmarks, tags, etc. In March the library will post a large display about library services, library value and information about the referendum.
- II. Library Card Policy: Beginning February, patrons must present a library card to the front desk for all circulation services. The one exception is services over the phone. All replacement card fees will be waived through February.
- III. TV Series Checkout Length: The checkout period for TV Series will be extended from 7 to 21 days.
- IV. Soda Vending Machine: Due to disuse, the soda vending machine has been removed.
- V. Book Sale: The library held a book sale January 9-14. Items sold were weeded from the Adult Fiction section.
- VI. Mediacom Contract: The library has a contract with Mediacom until November 2025. The New Windsor Telephone Company has stated that once construction of fiber optic / telephone services is complete, we can join at our convenience to avoid having to break contract with Mediacom.
- VII. Kindness Project With Sherrard Grade School: The library has partnered with Jackie Kelly's 4<sup>th</sup> grade class on a "Kindness Project."
- VIII. Donations: Donations have been received from Birdies for Charity (\$950), The Churchill Family Foundation and Lowell N. Johnson Charitable Foundation. Thank you notes have been sent.
- IX. Credit Card Fraud: First National Bank of Omaha detected fraud on the Director's credit card and blocked these charges. A new credit card was issued with 48 hours.
- X. Dining Tour: Quad Cities Dining Tour coupon books were not published this year.
