133 This historic urban carriage house has been renovated and returned to its original glory. A very modern update comes with the new overhead carriage house doors. The focal point has effectively been shifted away from the front door to the "garage" doors by the placement of black urns and wall-mounted lanterns on each side and an elaborate balcony railing above. The combination of a deep terra-cotta

field color and a cherry stain on the doors is unusual, but works very well together, especially with black details on the house that create a dark contrast for the scheme. The heavy cornice dresses up particularly well in black, and the repetition of color on the windows, balcony, stars, light, and hitching posts reinforces the color and contributes to its dramatic presence on this old city street. This home is a treasure.
