**Governor's Executive Order No. 122
As it Pertains to Hampton Township**

The physical operations of all Non-Essential Construction Projects shall cease when this order takes effect.

Essential Projects shall be defined as follows:

- A. Health Care Facilities- Pharmaceutical Manufacturing Facilities
- B. Transportation Projects, Roads, Bridges, Mass Transit or Physical Infrastructure, Airports, Seaports
- C. Utility Projects, Energy & Electrical Production
- D. Residential Projects for Affordable Housing
- E. Schools
- F. Projects already underway including Single Family Homes, or an Individual Apartment Unit where an individual already resides with a construction crew of 5 or fewer individuals. This includes additions to single family homes such as solar panels.
- G. Projects already underway including a residential unit for which a Tenant or Buyer has already entered into a legally binding agreement to occupy the unit by a certain date; and construction is necessary to ensure the unit availability by that date.
- H. Projects involving facilities at which any one or more of the following takes place: The manufacture, distribution, storage, or servicing of goods or products that are sold by online retail businesses or essential retail businesses, as defined by Executive Order No. 107(2020) and subsequent Administrative Orders adopted to that order.
- I. Data centers
- J. Projects necessary for the delivery of Essential Social Services, including Homeless Shelters.
- K. Any project to support Law Enforcement or First Responder Units.
- L. Any project that is ordered by Federal, State, County or Municipal Government or any project that must be completed to meet a deadline established by the Federal Government.
- M. Any work on a new essential building that is required to ensure the structural integrity or any hazards.
- N. Any emergency repairs necessary to ensure the health & safety of Residents.

This Order takes effect Friday, April 10, 2020 at 8pm until Further Notice.
