

# Martin's closing 32 is best for nine holes

Both Bailey and Sandie birdied the par-5 15th, then Sandie sneaked to within two shots with a par on the 16th as Bailey bogeyed. But Sandie double-bogeyed the 17th, and Bailey had a four-shot lead with a hole to go.

Last year, Bailey came out of the pack to win, and he admitted it was a different situation this year being the front-runner.

"It's easier to play from two or three shots back than it is when you're in the lead," he said.

McCoy and Peck can attest to that. McCoy, a junior-to-be at Wichita State, had a one-under 71 in the morning, then shot a one-under 35 on his last trip to finish the tournament at one-over 181. He had qualified with a 75. Peck came from even further back. He qualified with a 76, but shot 72-33 to also finish at 181. Sandie was the third player at that figure after a 39 on his last nine.

John Martin saved the best for last and finished fifth as a result. He carded the lowest nine-hole score of the tournament, a four-under 32, to finish at 182. Martin birdied the first four holes his last time out, then got it to five under with a birdie at 15 before giving one back a hole later.
