



Editor's 2¢ worth: Our problem with sign-ups and people signing up but not paying at the time or the day of the class has continued. When you sign up for a class the teacher purchases the surface(s) for the class and additional supplies to meet requirement for completing the project. If you don't pay at sign up or show up with the fee at the meeting the teaches then ends up with extra surfaces and more supplies than needed for the project. These teachers don't charge you for their time teaching or time prepping the surfaces. All of this costs the teacher money and since they don't make any money for teaching or profit on the projects it is going to get to the point the teachers are thinking twice about scheduling a class. It is therefore necessary to follow through and implement the new sign up announced originally in the August 2022 newsletter. If you have not paid at the time of your sign-up you will have to have your money sent to Laura by the first day of the month the class is held. If Laura does not receive the money by that date your name will NOT be counted as a student and a surface will NOT be available for you. If you have paid and do not attend the class or notify Laura by the beginning of the month please have someone pick up the piece for you since we cannot give refunds after the teacher has purchased surface and supplies for the class. We're sorry this has to be done but our teachers donate their time and talents to give us classes and expand our knowledge. It shouldn't cost them money to do so. We don't want to lose our teachers. PLEASE pay when you sign ир.

RETREAT

Mark your calendars for October 5th through 8th, 2023.

For those of you who have never been to Crestfield you will be using 3 different buildings. Your room and two classrooms are in one, two large rooms where multiple classes are in the second building and the cafeteria is in the third. Sidewalks connect the three buildings and an awning covers the walkway from your rooms to the cafeteria. Several of us have mobility problems, most have walkers or canes and I use a scooter. We have all managed to get from building to building with no real problem. I've even become pretty good at opening doors.

The Booklets were all distributed at the May Meeting. The Booklet is also on line at GTDP.org. You can print the book in one of two ways, Booklet style or a one-page style.

This year you have the options of eating there for \$12 per meal or you can go into Slippery Rock and have meals there. If you want dessert with dinner there will be an additional \$3 fee. Please mark your choices on your Registration form, Meal tickets will be given to you at Registration for each meal you indicated on the Registration Form.

Crestview does not handle individual payments so your room, food, registration and class will have to be paid to GTDP. Deadline for Registration is September 17th. After that Registration will be \$45 rather than \$40. All monies must be paid prior to the first of October. Please make checks payable to GTDP. As a reminder, your room fee is a flat \$85 per day so that is divided by the amount of people each night. If there are 2 people in a room it's \$42.50 each person per night. If there are 3 in a room it's \$28.50 per night. However if the room has 3 in it and someone only stays 2 nights that night for the other 2 people must pay \$42.50 that night then \$28.50 the other 2.nights. Hope that clears up any questions.

BOARD RESPONSIBILITIES

President Leads the meeting and guarantees all Chairmen do their jobs, has paperwork audited at the end of the year and handles any questions/problems Chairmen may have.

1st **VP** (Program Chair) arranges everything related to classes such as booking Teachers including GTDP teachers and National Teachers and their requirements, arranging dates for classes, fee for classes, supplies needed etc.

2nd VP (Membership Chair) receives payment of dues, keeps a list of members and checks them in at meeting and produces the Membership Book.

Recording Secretary records the actions at each Chapter and Board Meetings, compiles a list of Motions adding all to all previous records.

Treasurer handles all moneys from 4 Bank accounts and 3 GTDP Accounts, submits a year-end report to National and files taxes at the end of the year.

Publicity Chairman finds newspapers or free flyer in the area that you know will publish GTDP's classes, Retreat or Basket Luncheon information.

Newsletter Editor publishes the Newsletter 6 times a year in the off months of the Meetings. They collect Information from each Chairman, publishes the minutes and any information of interest to members.

Ways and Means Chairman handles raffles every meeting soliciting items from the Membership for the table.

Corresponding Secretary sends cards to someone who is ill, in the hospital, lost a family member or thank you cards.

Historian keeps a record of actions at each meeting and any outside GTDP activities.

Hospitality handles the purchase of supplies needed for our pot luck luncheons such as utensils, plates, napkins, pop and table coverings; arranges catering for the January Meeting and Christmas Party and gives suggestions for what to bring the remaining Meetings.

Parliamentarian makes sure we follow Roberts Rules of Order.

Decorative Painting Month Chairman finds places to display art work in October.

Spring Basket Luncheon Chairman makes all arrangements for our Luncheon, choosing a date, meals, centerpieces, favors, door prizes and main raffle.

Service Chairman finds nonprofit groups or deserving organization that needs help other than monetary where we can use our painting skills for useful items to the individuals.

Nominating Chairman makes phone calls or speaks directly to people requesting people run for office.
