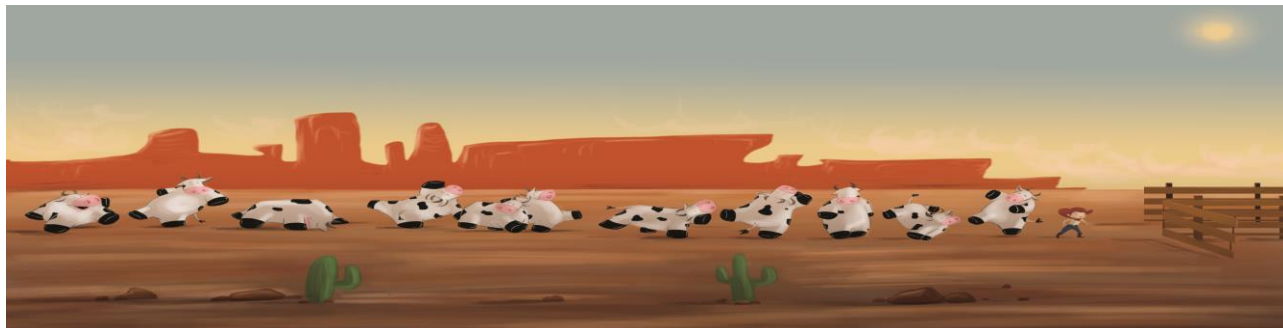


SOUTHERN SAYINGS
