Ted H. Schubel, 85 of Port Austin, former Huron County Register of Deeds, passed away Tuesday, April 15 at the Huron Medical Care Facility, near Bad Axe, following a long illness.

He was born May 15, 1901 in Grindstone City, son of the late John and Hester (Collons) Schubel. On July 15, 1932, he was united in marriage to Alberta Gobel in Flint.

Mr. Schubel held various township offices and belonged to several clubs, and was former president of Port Austin State Bank. He also was employed by the Hubbard Bank in Bad Axe and Caseville.
