Unity Point has also been utilizing Jane Berger & Jimi in the Rehab department where Jimi enhances patients Occupational or Physical therapy sessions and helps the patients to make progress while having fun with a therapy dog. Jimi is a natural when it comes to knowing what the patients need and how to get them to work.

The end of the school year brought requests for the dogs to visit area colleges during finals week. We had visits to Briar Cliff University, Morningside College and St. Luke's School of Nursing. The dogs were very popular during these visits with the students showing great appreciation for having the dogs available to them.

Perry Creek Elementary School organized a



very generous fundraiser for STARS and shortly after that requested that the dogs visit the school to keep the kids thinking about what all we have to offer at STARS. The kids were great with the dogs and it was a mutually enjoyable visits for all involved.

We are still in need of adding members to our group so we can offer our services to more places. In the last month alone I received requests from 4 new places that I, unfortunately, could not add to our calendar because we do not have enough members.
