We have been re-awakened to "The Miracle of Tiyamike" in the last few months. We realised the challenges and shortfalls in income had a large part in bringing us and our staff to a survivor mentality. We have so much appreciation for Mike, General Manager/Accts and Bello, Operations Manager who we rely on greatly and have with appreciation watched as they have matured into the main management core along with several ladies (Dinna book keeping/payroll, Eliza Madi ladies supervisor, Mary M. our Kitchen supervisor) as advisors. Pastor Haji is also an advisor. Pam and I have been as support for several years, with myself (Will) carrying the ball for herding the funds received thru the process of exchange, banking and eventual deposit to an accessible account in the valley where Tiyamike is situated. We are also in expectation of coming into relationship with a person willing, knowledgeable and especially drawn by Holy Spirit to look after the Tiyamike web site.
