

RECORD OF PROCEEDINGS

TOWN OF KREMMLING
REGULAR TOWN BOARD MEETING
March 21, 2018

The Board of Trustees, for the Town of Kremmling, met in the boardroom located at 200 Eagle Avenue. Mayor Thomas Clark called the meeting to order at 6:30 p.m. Trustees present: Gina Schroeder, Jason Wikberg, Wes Howell, Guy Bakke, and Grace Bohall. Staff present: Town Manager Mark Campbell, Chief Scott Spade, and Public Works Director Jason Bock.

BOHALL MOVED TO APPROVE THE REGULAR TOWN BOARD MEETING MINUTES OF MARCH 7, 2018. SCHROEDER SECONDED. ALL "AYE" VOTES.

Trustee Bakke entered at 6:32 pm.

SCHROEDER MOVED TO APPROVE THE EXPEDITURES FROM MARCH 8, 2018 THROUGH MARCH 21, 2018, IN THE AMOUNT OF \$155,217.64. HOWELL SECONDED. ALL "AYE" VOTES.

HOWELL MOVED TO APPROVE THE AGENDA AS AMENDED. SCHROEDER SECONDED. ALL "AYE" VOTES.

Marty Schroeder spoke to the board, as he is opening a new hot dog cart in town. The adult softball league has asked them to run concessions at the ballfield this summer. The board had no issues with it, and wished them well in their endeavors.

The Mayor reported:

- February precipitation was 173% of average.
- He and Manager Campbell met with the town's water engineers for the source water protection plan and also the attorney.
- Mayor Clark inquired as to whether the board would like to have Sheriff Schroetlin come back to the next board meeting. The board concurred that Sheriff Schroetlin did not need to be present, but that they would like to discuss his proposal further at the next meeting.
- The old middle school has been purchased by the Middle Park Medical Center. They have plans to move their laundry and physical therapy departments there, and also build 4 apartments into the building, along with planning for other future items that may come up.

The Police Chief reported:

- He was involved in a vehicle accident last week, and Officer Willson was in the hospital for emergency appendicitis surgery.
- They have been working on getting caught up on all of their training.

The Public works Director reported:

- There was a glitch at the water plant over the weekend, but it back up and running.
- They have been doing equipment maintenance and getting this ready for spring.



The Manager reported:

- The appraiser has been working on getting Mr. Smith's property appraisals done, and he is still working towards having them done by mid April.
- He met with the Town of Hot Sulphur about the possibility of sharing a code enforcement officer, with Kremmling using that person for 12 hours a month. It has been budgeted, and he will continue to talk with them about the feasibility.
- Our franchise agreement with Xcel Energy will expire in the next year, so there may be a representative coming in the next few months.

Trustee Howell would like to see the Clerk and Treasurer have a job review when the new board is sworn into office. The board all concurred.
