In addition, please ask your gardener to cut back any shrubbery that might be overgrowing the roadway obstructing clear visibility for motorists and pedestrians alike, particularly at intersections and blind or tight roadways.

The Village will be enhancing our beautification program by installing hanging flower baskets on our street light poles. We anticipate this project being complete by mid July.
