MAY SPEAKER - BITSY KEMPER

Bitsy provided us with tips for writing children's books, many of which are appropriate for any genre. For instance, every story should have a beginning, middle, and end. The main character should be transformed in some way by what occurs in the story. It should have mainstream appeal with your main character the same age or slightly older than your target audience.

She suggested the following book styles for age groups: 0-3 Board Books 3-7 Picture Books 5-8 Early Readers 7-9 Chapter Books 8-12 Middle Grade 12-7 Young Adult 14-21 New Adult




The Trumpeter's New Clothes
