MISCELLANEOUS NEWS

Nov 2019 Financial Report

Simplified Report – Everything is going as planned. \$4,000 was removed from investments in November to help cover the budget.

Checking Account Balance: \$3,078.19

Investment Account Balance (DCEF): \$271,913.62

November Income (Offerings): \$4,487.06 actual, \$5,885.67 adjusted November Expenses/Outreach: \$7,033.45 actual, \$7,266.45 adjusted

* Adjusted takes into consideration early offerings and the amount from investments in the budget and pro-rates these throughout the year. For expenses the insurance cost expense is pro-rated throughout the year and unusual, unplanned expenses may be excluded as noted below. This provides a better month - to - month picture of how we're doing than the actual numbers. There were no unusual expenses or income in November.

At the Congregational Meeting on November, 17th, the 2020 budget was discussed and passed. If you missed the meeting, and would like a copy of the budget, see Diane. There is one thing I forgot to discuss at the meeting before we took the vote. We have allocated \$3,000 under Capital Improvements to have the parking lot resealed and restriped in 2020. At this point, we have only one estimate, for \$4,500. We will get more estimates before the work is done, but, if this ends up being the company we use, our plan is to use \$3,000 from the budget and to make up the rest via a fundraiser. We will be asking people contribute to "sponsor" a parking spot. (Just so there's no confusion – we're not "selling" parking spots. You won't have an assigned spot when this

is all over.)
