- A. Electric Cars

- B. Pond Ownership and Fence Problem
  - i. It was determined that RCC owns the entirety of the pond
  - ii. Mark Graham gave a great report on the property and what needs repair
  - iii. The bank of the pond is steep. There is danger there
  - iv. Kids/people are fishing without permission
  - v. Our liability could take a hit if there was an accident
  - vi. The perimeter fence needs repair in 3 places
  - vii. Mark Graham has offered to provide the labor to repair the fence
  - viii. Our only cost will be the materials to repair the fence
    - ix. Signage has been ordered to indicates "Private Property" and "No Fishing".
    - x. Becky moved and Frank seconded motion to repair fence and put up signs.
    - xi. Motion carried
- C. Sump Pumps
  - i. RCC is responsible for sump pumps
  - ii. Board members will handle inspections
