Directions

Keepstone Farm: 412 Russell Road, Berryville, Virginia. Is located less than a mile from Route 7 West and is six miles east of I-81. It is easily accessible from Northern Virginia, West Virginia, Pennsylvania and Maryland using all major highways. Note: Route 7 is also called Harry Byrd Hwy.

From the East: From Leesburg VA, take Route 7 West. Passing 2 traffic lights after the Rt 340 exit for Berryville, turn Right on Russell Road (Rt 660).

From the West (I-81): Take Exit 315, Rt 7 East at Winchester VA. Go ~ 6 miles, turn Left on Russell Road (Rt 660). Follow * directions above.

From the North (Frederick MD) Take Rt 340/15 South, bearing right on 340 South at the split. Follow 340 to Charles Town WV, and continue South on 340 to Rt 7 West at Berryville VA. Turn right onto Russell Rd. Follow * directions above.

From the South (Route 66 West): Take Rt. 17 North towards Paris, VA. At the traffic light, turn Left onto Route 50 West toward Winchester. Follow Rt. 50 West to Route 340 North (Sheetz Station at light) - turn Right. Go into Berryville and turn Left at the light onto West Main Street. At the next light, turn left onto Route 7 - going West. Go approximately 1.5 miles and turn Right onto Russell Road (Rt. 660) Follow * directions above.

Closing of Entries/Alternates and Move-Ups (AKC Herding Rules & Regulations, Section 13):

- CLOSING: Friday, October 21, 2016 at 4:00 P.M. After closing entries cannot be accepted, changed or cancelled, except for move-ups.
- When trial entry limits have been reached all additional entries received prior to the closing date will go on an alternate's list for each level that exceeds the published limit(s). This trial will keep an alternate list of five (5) runs per stock/course.
- Entrants on the alternates list must check in with the Herding Secretary at the trial 30 minutes before the commencement of their class.
- Entry fee will be refunded to the alternates whose dogs do not have an opportunity to run.
- Requests for move-up must be given to the Secretary 30 minutes prior to the trial starting.

Bitches in Season will be run at the end of the running order in all trial and test classes.

Exhibitors should follow their veterinarians' recommendation to assure their dogs are free of internal and external parasites, any communicable diseases, and have appropriate vaccinations.

Refund Policy

- Entry fees will not be refunded in the event that a dog is absent, disqualified, or excused by the Judge or Veterinarian, or barred from competition by action of the Show Committee. If because of riots, civil disturbances, or other acts beyond the control of the show giving club, it is impossible to open or complete the show, no refunds will be made.
- Refunds of entries pulled after closing date will be made as long as an alternate is available to replace the run.
- No refund for duplicate entries or any other cause beyond the control of the PVSSC after the closing date (Rules Applying to Dog Shows, Chapter 11, Section 6) including injured or sick dogs or handlers. In the event of a spouse, sibling, parent or entered dog's untimely death, an event committee refund decision will be made.
- The PVSSC may decline any entries for cause and may remove any dog on account of disease, viciousness, or other cause and no one shall have any claim or recourse against the PVSSC or any official thereof. In this case, no refund will be made.

HERDING INSTINST TEST - DAY OF TRIAL ENTRIES

- Day of Trial entries will be offered if the judging limit for the day has not be reached
- Exhibitors should submit an entry form one (1) hour prior to the listed start time for Instinct Tests. The Judging Program will be on the PVSSC website prior to the trial date.

A-Sheep Course Field:

- Trial 1 will use the course that is shared with the cattle. Course size is 155'x 255'. The course lay-out is the reverse of the sample diagrams in the AKC Herding Regulations, Chapter V Course A.
- Trial 2 will use the new course adjacent to the road/parking. Course size is 100' x 200'. The course layout is the same as the sample diagram that appears in the AKC Herding Regulations, Chapter V Course A.

- Sheep (Katahdin, Katahdin/Dorper cross, African and Barbados Blackbelly mixes), 3-5 sheep/run in trial classes. Value of sheep: \$300 each
- Ducks (Swedish), 5 ducks per run Value of ducks: \$50 each
- Cattle (Holstein, Angus, Black Baldy and Belted Galloway), 3 cattle per run Value of cattle: \$1,200 each
