As always, we like to see our Aerie busy and have all those there to be having a good time. Please take care of yourselves and each other and we hope to see you soon.

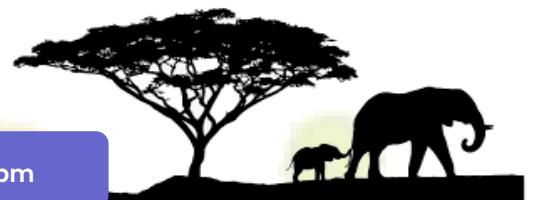
