(Shire medical education Complex)

Beginning and end of Free education!  
Free education uses C.G. NATm!



It starts: HE from age '0-9', SHE from age '0-16' and Seniors from age '63 onwards until end. Attending SmeC is mandatory for She's conceiving, until children have completed attending SmeC. SmeC is a career path for only SHE (mothers) ! Every SmeC has a 'Gathering'.

Free Education at **SmeC**: Children attend 6 days a week from 1 hour after Sunrise to 1 hour before Sunset. Children are provided with cover all, footwear, educational material, food and drink. They rest, have a bath (New born club), the others have a shower.

Mothers attend 6 days a week from 1 hour after Sunrise to 1 hour before Sunset (they get 3 hour break). Mothers are provided with cover all, footwear, food, drink and get paid (1 x **wmw**). Can shower. **Note!** When leaving, Mothers and Children change. Everything provided stays. There is no home work.

**Age 0–2**: a newborn (boy, girl) attends with his mother a '**SmeC: New-born club**' 6 days a week. Newborn on completing year 2 receive '**New born club Diploma**' Mothers completing 280 hours club learning and teaching receive: 'Year 1 Apprenticeship 'SmeC' Certificate'

**Age 3–9**: boys, girls (Scholars) attend 6 days a week mixed classes (co-ed) '**SmeC: Basic School**' Scholars on completing year 9 receive '**Basic School Diploma**'. Mothers completing 140 hours Basic School learning and teaching receive: 'Year 2 apprenticeship 'SmeC' Certificate'

**Age 10–14**: girls (Scholars) attend 6 days a week girls only classes at '**SmeC: Girl's only School**'. Scholars on completing year 14 receive '**Girl only School Diploma**' Mothers completing 140 hours Girl only School learning, teaching receive: 'Medical Education Trade Certificate'.

**Age 15–16**: girls (Scholars) attend 6 days a week paid (1 x **wmw**) classes at '**SmeC: Family College**'. Scholars on completing year 16 receive '**Family College Diploma**'

**62 year** old She teach: She passes on life experiences to next generation (paid 3 x **wmw**) at **Family College**.

**Age 63** or over senior He, She (co-ed) education is available at '**SmeC: Senior Activity Club**'.

## She career path: **SmeC Manager**

**\*Basic:** After an opening, promoted by seniority!

After She completed a 'Holy Matrimony' Contract'. Has a 'Medical, Education Trade Certificate'. She starts work as 'Nurse' (wmw2).

After 1 year work-experience as 'Nurse' qualifies\* to become 'Senior-Nurse' (wmw3).

After 1 year work experience as 'Senior Nurse' qualifies to attend 'PHeC / Technical College' earns 'Supervisor Certificate'. When there is an opening promoted\* to 'Mid wife' (wmw4).

After 1 year work experience as 'Mid wife' qualifies to attend 'PHeC / Leadership College' earns 'Leader Diploma'. When there is an opening promoted\* to 'Medic' (wmw5).

After 1 year work experience as 'Medic' qualifies to attend 'PHeC / Leadership College' earns 'Manager Diploma'. When there is an opening promoted\* to 'Matron' (wmw6).

After 1 year work experience as 'Matron' qualifies to attend 'PDEc Leadership Camp' earns 'Administrator Degree'. When there is an opening promoted\* to 'SmeC Manager' (wmw7). Joins the 'Provincial Adviser pool'.

**SmeC** is the hub of community living most She will spend most of their lives there. She's and children need to socialize to live up to their full potential. Seniors volunteer! Communal living is the community raising children rather than individuals.

**She's** start attending 'SmeC for prenatal activities. (**Note!** He is not involved) From 3 weeks before birth onwards She attends SmeC daily. This continuous after birth. She will be involved with SmeC until all her children have completed their education there. She then starts a career. She will have completed an Apprenticeship (Medical Education Trade Certificate). She will attend 'SmeC' Gatherings. Eventually She will be attending Senior Activity Club.

SmeC free medical education part of Custodian Guardian community!

Education is a collaboration between parents, educators and medics. It involves Free education, Free health and Apprenticeships. No, homework! No, non government education! No, Universities!

1<sup>st</sup> Learn, when comprehending, start teaching. In free education fast learners teach slow learners. At work the experienced worker trains newcomers. At home, grandparents teach children, grand children. Parents teach children.

Evolution (good enough for 1 God) progresses by building on existing and then creating new. Reading a good piece of writing encourages the mind to lift one's intellect to the high standard of the original. Stopping this thinking to concentrate on rewriting is mediocre time wasting education. Be smart, 'Plagiarize'.

**Homework** is the most dishonest and useless form of learning or teaching. A Scholar is under pressure from distractions, ignorance, friends, parents, time line... Most homework is not done by the scholar who is being assessed and graded. Homework because of its dishonest nature is useless and misleading for assessment. Parents and educators supporting homework, support cheating, dishonesty. **No homework!**

**Assessment:** Is needed to make Teach and Learn useful and effective.

Scholar is assessed for comprehension assignments completed in class. Whenever a study module is completed, Scholars get assignments to assess comprehension. The comprehension assignments are completed in class. Pass rate is 70% comprehension. A fail and the scholar has to repeat the study-module until a pass. Only the module needs repeating not the whole year.

There is no final year Assessment or final examination (useless activity). Assessment is only for each module, not for accumulated modules. Once a Scholar has passed all set modules a Course Certificate is issued.

**SmeC** has a bell tower. Every day at 'Sunrise', 'Midday', 'Sunset' it rings for 1 minute. This ringing celebrates **1 God** giving us daylight through sunlight. Days 1-6 (work week), 1 hour after Sunrise, 1 hour before Sunset the bell rings for 2 minutes. Signaling work start and work end. Day 7 (Fun Day) 1 hour after Sunrise and 1 hour before Sunset the bell rings for 3 minutes. It lets **1 God** and community know there is a '**Gathering**'.
