The Board discussed the cautionary tale about Conflict of Interest some landscaping companies may have in getting the contract from the HON, while providing discounts to members of the HON.

A Motion was brought forth by Brian Culp to establish a better process for "project closeout" reports from the DRC when members have completed primary construction and completed their 6-mopnth post construction landscaping completion requirements. Motion passed 5 Yes, 0 No.

David brought up that the Board should proceed with a legal review of the CC&Rs by legal counsel for updating the annual dues for 2024. All agreed.
