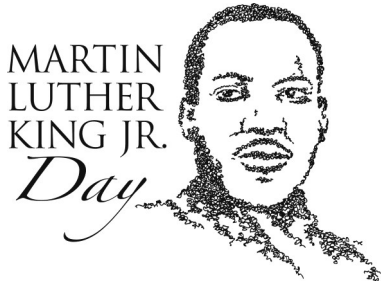

Residents are reminded that all dogs 6 months and older are to be registered with the city every year by April 1st.

Price for tags are \$10 per dog. After April 1st, the price increases to \$15 per dog.
