

Color Stamp & Deboss

Deboss

Also referred to as blind deboss, this classic method allows you to leave an impression--or rather, a depression-- of your logo onto a material's surface. We create a die and then heat-press it into the material. What's left behind is a clean, crisp logo you can see and feel. It's ideal on leather, Durahyde, UltraHyde, Scuba, recycled rubber and paperboard products.

Color Stamp

Add the high-end look of foil to your company logo with color stamping. Simple one-color designs are enhanced when a die is used to apply colored foil to a material's surface.

Color Fill

Color fill combines color stamping and debossing. We begin with creating a die of your artwork. Then we color stamp your logo onto the material, and follow this step with a blind deboss, with the same die. This method is available only on vinyl patches (patch colors available in tan or black).



Domes

To add dimension and shine to your logo, place it under a clear, high-gloss polyurethane dome (black, gray and white bezels available).



Logo 3D

Logo 3D is another great choice for adding dimension to your logo. These molded rubber patches come in a variety of shapes and colors and are best suited for multi-color logos.
