#### **Remembering Dave Dolliver** by Steve Baima

Ladies and Gentlemen: It is with great sadness that I inform you of the passing of Dave Dolliver. Dave was taken under hospice care for several days and died the morning of December 14th. Chris Statz mad some announcements on social media. For those of you that are not involved with social media, like facebook, you probably did not get this news. Dave was one of the original founding members of the Washington Historical Gunmakers Guild. He was a lifetime member of the Cascade Mountain Men also. Dave lived in east Bellevue, in the Hilltop Community during his years as a machinist at the Boeing Company. When he retired, he moved to a home between Olympia and Shelton. He had a detached shop that was half wood shop and half metal shop. He turned out many muzzle loading rifles under the name of Lopez Longrifles. Even after the sale of his home and moving into an assisted living apartment, he continued to build guns. The last one that he built was an English Sporting rifle. He donated it to the guild for our auction last year. The winning bidder got a fine rifle and one of Dave's last although I know



that he was working on a Christian Springs rifle earlier this year. He was a regular at all of the workshop events including the gunmakers classes, horn and accoutrement activities and the annual gun show at Monroe. Most of us in the muzzle loading community have benefitted directly by being associated with Dave Dolliver. He was always there to help out when we encountered problems with our rifles or had problems with a build project. Dave will be missed by all of us.

#### WSMA MEMBERSHIP BENEFITS

The following represents a part of ongoing WSMA activities. Some have time frames and deadlines, which need to be considered. Application Forms are available from the WSMA website.

<u>WSMA Monthly Newsletter</u>. Receive the monthly WSMA newsletter with stories and articles about upcoming events. In order to save postage and printing costs, the newsletter will be sent by e-mail. Paper copies can be mailed upon request.

<u>WSMA Annual Events Calendar.</u> A comprehensive list of events throughout the Pacific Northwest which is posted and kept updated on the WSMA website.

<u>WSMA and the WDFW</u>: The WSMA represents the muzzleloader hunters on a statewide basis. We participate and are involved with the WA Department of Fish and Wildlife committees to ensure muzzleloader hunters have input on future muzzleloader hunting opportunities in Washington State.

<u>WSMA Pilgrim Award</u>: Recognizes the first time Muzzleloader shooters at rendezvous events. It is presented by a WSMA representative at scheduled events where possible.

WSMA Youth Activity Incentive Grants: Based on applications received each year prior to December 1<sup>st</sup>. Amount is based on available funds and established need and worthiness of the program. Open to member clubs as well as other youth organizations desiring to facilitate muzzleloading shooting programs. Applications need to reach the WSMA by Dec 1<sup>st</sup>. Late applications may be considered. Additional awards and prizes may be presented by the WSMA based on available funds.

<u>WSMA Youth Rondy Boxes</u>: Everything for a kid to participate in rendezvous! WSMA has three boxes containing a rifle, shooting bag, powder flask, powder, ball, patches, knife and hawk to get started. The boxes are presented at the Annual Fundraising Banquet for a one year loan, and collected back and reconstituted for the next youth. Applications are available on the website.

<u>WSMA Sanctioned Event Medals</u>. WSMA gold, silver, and bronze medals are available for specific, dedicated events submitted to the Events Booshway by Dec 1<sup>st</sup> and approved by the Executive Committee. Up to 24 medals provided at no cost to the member organizations based on submitted programs. Additional medals available at cost.

<u>WSMA Annual Fundraising Banquet</u>. Each March the WSMA gathers for a catered meal and night of fun with the purpose of raising money to support WSMA activities. The highlight of the event is the live auction, with items donated by our traders and members. Please join in the fun.

All WSMA members are encouraged to participate in all of these membership benefits. WSMA is the key to more fun and enjoyment in the great sport of Muzzleloading.
