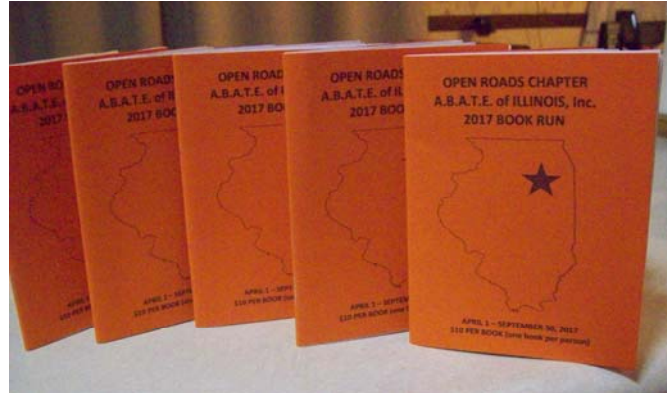


# Summer Run Books
