#### DAY OF SHOW - HORSES/PONIES FLAT WORK ONLY

\*\* Class 1 – Open Hunter Derby – Separate Two-Round Classic. Open to Everyone. Horses Only. Fences will be 3' with "option" fences in a round at 3'3".

To be shown over a Hunter Classic type course with a minimum of 10 fences at the required height. To be judged on performance, hunter pace, jumping style, quality, and substance and movement under the open numerical scoring system. ONE bonus point will be added to base score for each higher "option fence" jumped. The Top 12 will return for the Handy round over a course of 8 to 10 fences. To be judged on style, brilliance, and handiness. Handiness will be rewarded in the base score. One bonus point will be added to base score for each higher "option" fence jumped. Scores will be added to determine the winner. \$250.00 prize money split 1st through 6th. Ribbons 1st – 8th.

\*\* Class 2 – Jr/Adult Hunter Derby – Separate Two-Round Classic. Open to Juniors and Adult riders. No professionals. Horses Only. Fences will be 2'9" with "option" fences in a round at 3'.

To be shown over a Hunter Classic type course with a minimum of 10 fences at the required height. To be judged on performance, hunter pace, jumping style, quality, and substance and movement under the open numerical scoring system. ONE bonus point will be added to base score for each higher "option fence" jumped. The Top 12 will return for the Handy round over a course of 8 to 10 fences. To be judged on style, brilliance, and handiness. Handiness will be rewarded in the base score. One bonus point will be added to base score for each higher "option" fence jumped. Scores will be added to determine the winner. \$250.00 prize money split 1st through 6th. Ribbons 1st – 8th.

\*\* Class 3 – Children or Adult Hunter Derby – Open to Children or Adult Amateurs on horses or ponies. Separate two-round classic. Fences will be 2' in height with 3 option fences in a round at 2'6" in height.

To be shown over a Hunter Classic type course with a minimum of 10 fences at the required height. To be judged on performance, hunter pace, jumping style, quality, and substance and movement under the open numerical scoring system. ONE bonus point will be added to base score for each higher "option fence" jumped. The Top 12 will return for the Handy round over a course of 8 to 10 fences. To be judged on style, brilliance, and handiness. Handiness will be rewarded in the base score. One bonus point will be added to base score for each higher "option" fence jumped. Scores will be added to determine the winner.

\$250.00 prize money split 1st through 6th. Ribbons 1st – 8th.

#### \*\* Class 4 - Pony Hunter Derby - (Junior and ponies only)

Separate two-round classic. Open to Junior on Ponies only. Fences will be Small – Fences 2' in height with 3 "option" fences in a round at 2'3" Mediums – Fences will be 2'3" in height with 3 option fences in a round at 2'6" Large – Fences will be 2'6" in height with 3 option fences in a round at 2'9".

To be shown over a Hunter Classic type course with a minimum of 10 fences at the required height. To be judged on performance, hunter pace, jumping style, quality, and substance and movement under the open numerical scoring system. ONE bonus point will be added to base score for each higher "option fence" jumped. The Top 12 will return for the Handy round over a course of 8 to 10 fences. To be judged on style, brilliance, and handiness. Handiness will be rewarded in the base score. One bonus point will be added to base score for each higher "option" fence jumped. Scores will be added to determine the winner. \$250.00 prize money split 1st through 6th. Ribbons 1st – 8th

\*\* Class 5 – Short Stirrup/Long Stirrup – Separate Two-Round Classic. Open to Children and Adults. To be shown over a Hunter Classic type course with a minimum of 6 fences at the required height. Fences will be 18' in height with 3 option fences in a round at 2' in height. To be judged on performance, hunter pace, jumping style, quality, and substance and movement under the open numerical scoring system. ONE bonus point will be added to base score for each higher "option fence" jumped. The Top 12 will return for the Handy round over a course of 6 to 8 fences. To be judged on style, brilliance, and handiness. Handiness will be rewarded in the base score. One bonus point will be added to base score for each higher "option" fence jumped. Scores will be added to determine the winner. \$250.00 prize money split 1st through 6th. Ribbons 1st – 8th.

\$55 per class - Riders may only enter in one Derby class.

\$50 Stall Fee for riders who only show on Sunday

\$40 Stall Fee for riders who return from showing on Saturday

\$25 Warm Up (one per horse)

- Ring will close at 7:30 am
- Flat work only before class 1 no jumping allowed
- There will be a brief 10-minute break between each class to allow for hand walking
- Braiding is encouraged but not required
