* **February 21 at 6pm** – "Hoedown, Throwdown" at the Soundside Club

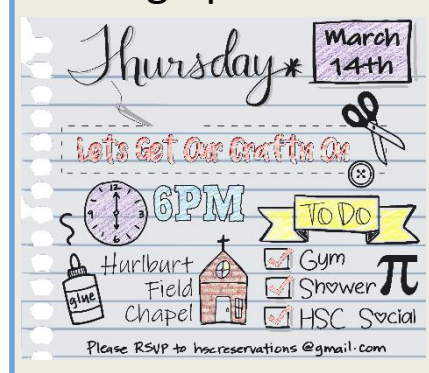
* **March 14 at 6pm** – "Let's get our Craft'n on" at the Hurlburt Field Chapel

Spouses' Scholarship

You are eligible to apply for this scholarship if you meet the following criteria:

- are a spouse of a Hurlburt Field military member (see eligibility requirements on application);
- are seeking an associate, undergraduate or graduate degree; and
- will attend an accredited college or university full- or part-time in the Fall of 2019.

High School Senior Turnaround Scholarship

You are eligible to apply for this scholarship if you meet the following criteria:

- are a Class of 2019 graduating senior and a dependent of a Hurlburt Field military member OR a dependent of a current HSC member (see eligibility requirements on application);
- will attend an accredited college or university full- or part-time in Fall 2019; and
- have a GPA of 3.0 your first year of high school and made significant improvement throughout the remainder of your high school career.

High School Senior Academic/Merit Scholarship

You are eligible to apply for this scholarship if you meet the following criteria:

- are a dependent of a Hurlburt Field military member OR a dependent of a current HSC member (see eligibility requirements on application);
- are a 2019 graduating senior; and
- have a GPA of 3.0 or higher (on a 4.0 scale).

College Scholarship

You are eligible to apply for this scholarship if you meet the following criteria:

- are a dependent of a Hurlburt Field military member (see eligibility requirements on application);
- are currently a student at an accredited college or university; and
- have a GPA of 3.0 or higher (on a 4.0 scale).

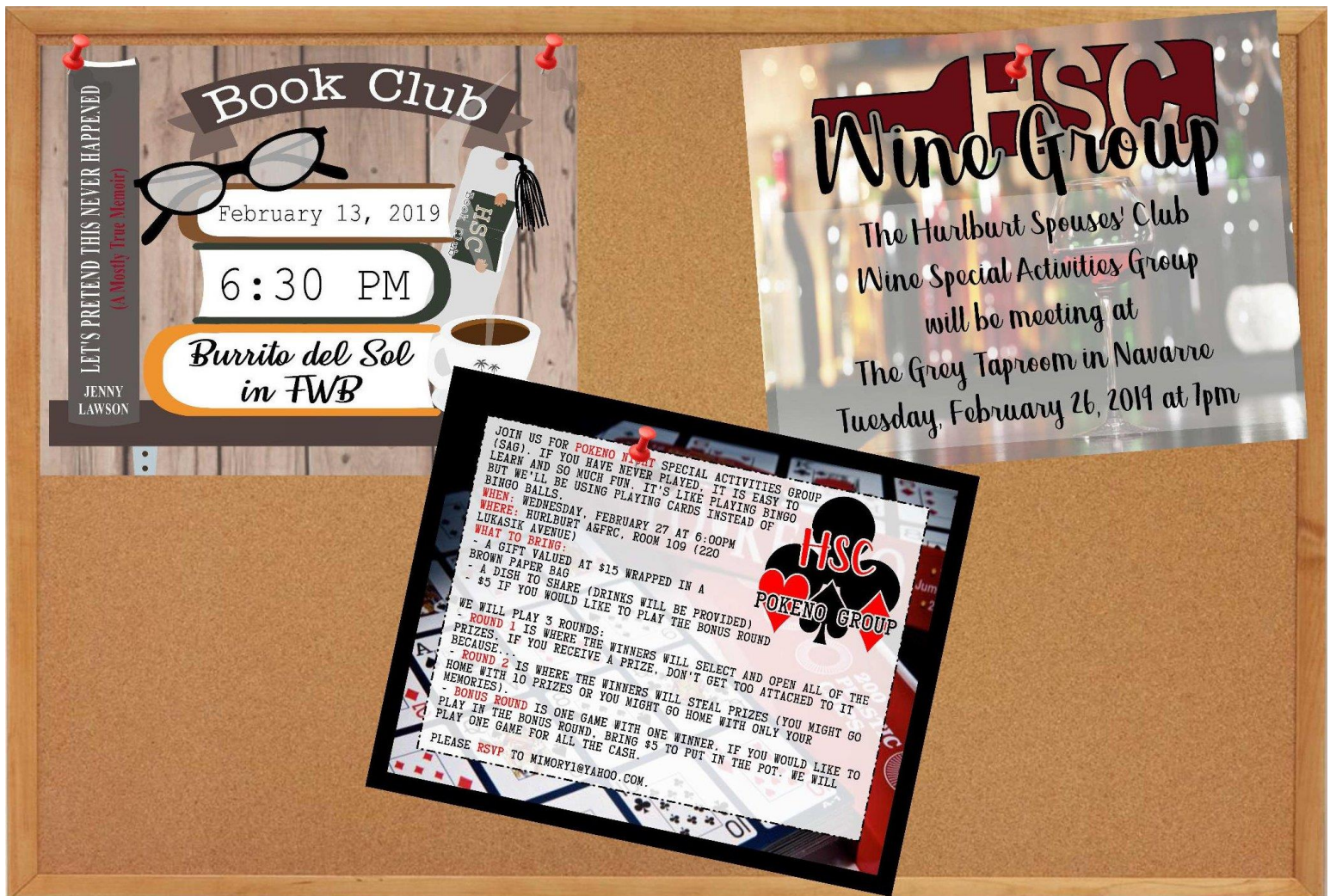

- **President** – Ensures all aspects of the HSC are addressed and Board Members are knowledgeable of their duties. Interfaces with Honorary Presidents and Advisors, keeping them informed of HSC business. Attends and presides over all Board Meetings and HSC Socials.
- **1st Vice President** – Oversees all the Social Committees of the HSC. Attends all Board Meetings and HSC Socials. Fills in for the President as needed. Reports to the President.
- **2nd Vice President** – Oversees all the Charitable and Scholarship Committees of the HSC. Attends all Board Meetings and HSC Socials. Reports to the President.
- **Secretary** – Executes all HSC correspondence. Arranges and sets up a meeting space for Board Meetings or any other special meetings called for by the President. Records and distributes minutes at Board Meetings. Attends all Board Meetings and HSC Socials. Reports to the President.
- **Administrative Treasurer** – Prepares monthly ledger sheets, pays expenses and receives monies related to the HSC Social Committees accounts. Prepares monthly reports (income and expense) for all Board Meetings. Prepares and submit books for annual audit/review. Attends all Board Meetings and HSC Socials. Fills in for the Charitable & Scholarship Treasurer as needed. Reports to the President.
- **Charitable & Scholarship Treasurer** – Acts as the custodian for the Charitable & Scholarship Fund. Handles all Charitable Financial Affairs in accordance with AFI 34-223, HSC Constitution, By-Laws and Operating Policies. Attends all Board Meetings and HSC Socials. Fills in for the Administrative Treasurer as needed. Reports to the President.
