## Why Sponsor?



This event is in its eighth year and each year attracts 1500-2000 local Youth Clubs to come participate in this event. Since 2017 the event was expanded to include the 5K Pumpkin Run on the Fullerton Trails that brings participants from this event to the Fullerton Stadium to be a part of this community – youth event celebrating fitness and assisting local youth in need. Since 2011 this event has raised \$150k for local youth clubs and over \$400K in Rotary Programs focused on prevention of Polio a chronic youth disease that is nearly eliminated from the world.

Since 2017-18 the Fullerton Rotary has joined forces with OC United and FLOCK in Fullerton to focus our efforts locally on assisting youth in need, and all funds raised beyond expenses will go towards these local youth programs supported by these three organizations.

### **OC UNITED – Since 2015**

OC United partners with local schools, businesses, and volunteers to develop united communities by empowering parents and children through after-school programming, mentorship, and neighborhood collaborations. OC United hosts a twice a week, trauma-informed after-school program that provides academic support, tutoring, mentoring, and character development to about 40 elementary school students at Valencia Park Elementary and also provides the SOLFul program to assist educationally at-risk elementary students (1st-6th grade) with academic and creative activities to help close the learning gap during the summer.

### **FLOCK – Since 2016**

Flock has given over \$100,000 since January 2016 to McKinney Vento Homeless youth in Fullerton providing items such as shoes, clothing, food, prescription eyeglasses, dental needs, transportation, sports equipment, school books and supplies, college scholarships and beyond.
