ANDREWS' 300 HIGHLIGHTS FIRST TOUR TITLE MAGNUSON PULLS AWAY FOR 2nd STRAIGHT WIN

ANDREWS SIMPLY AMAZING IN EARNING FIRST TOUR CROWN

ANDREWS UNSTOPPABLE IN WINNING 1st CHAMPIONSHIP

Throughout the 33-year history of the Greater Iowa Scholarship Bowling Tour, there have been countless memorable performances from many of the greatest youth and collegiate players in the Midwest, and from around the country. At this month's tour stop, another of those inspiring performances was etched in GISBT history. Vicki Andrews, a powerful 17-year-old from Indianola, lowa, had her big strike ball working, and the result was a dominant win – and her first career tour victory.

CHAMPION ROLLS 300 ON WAY TO VICTORY

Andrews gave an indication that the day would be special when she cranked out a 300 in the 2nd game of her qualifying round. It was her 2nd career perfecto, and it helped lead her into the finals within striking distance of the leader.

ANDREWS SETS TORRID PACE IN MATCH PLAY

Once match play began, she started striking and never stopped. She unleased games of 236, 268, 247, 245, 256 and 279 – for an amazing 255.16 average. She posted an unblemished 6-0 record, dispatching every opponent. Once she seized the lead, it just kept growing, with her final margin of victory exactly 300 pins. It was a dominant display for the ages.

Andrews' win was her first, and her best finish on tour. Her best previous effort was a runner-up finish at the 2023-2024 season opener in Davenport. This was the 5th match play finals appearance of her blossoming career.

The champ averaged 230.69 for her 13 games, and secured the championship plaque, a \$300 scholarship, and a permanent place on Champion's Row. She became the 96th different girl's champion since the tour's inception back in August 1992. Congratulations, Vicki!

5-TIME CHAMP MOORE NABS RUNNER-UP

Rachel Moore was this month's runner-up finisher. The right-hander used a big 265 closing game in her position round to vault into the runner-up spot. Moore, a 5-time GISBT champion was appearing in her 25th match play finals. The Keokuk, Iowa resident took home the \$200 runner-up check.

FRANKLIN TAKES 3rd IN TOUR DEBUT

Tori Franklin made a successful GISBT debut this month. The talented right-hander from Frisco, Texas rolled to a 3rd place finish, earning a \$150 scholarship for her performance.

QUALIFYING LEADER FINNEN PLACES 4th

Jana Finnen set a fast pace in qualifying by averaging 225.57 for her 7 games. The Orland Park, Illinois resident was making her GISBT debut and earned this month's high qualifier medal in the process. She led the field by 111 pins heading into match play, where she eventually finished in 4th place, earning a \$135 scholarship for her day's work.

LESSENGER EARNS 5th

Jersey Lessenger was this month's 5th place finisher. The right-hander from Fruitland, Iowa was making her first-ever finals appearance. She took home a \$120 scholarship for her efforts.

WAGNER SURVIVES ROLL-OFF, FINISHES 6th

After 7 games of qualifying, there was a tie for 6th place between Amber Wagner and Kayla Staub. Both players were looking for their first GISBT match play finals appearances, with a 9th and 10th frame roll-off required to decide who the final spot in match play would go to. Both players traded great shots, with Wagner coming out on top 48-40. Wagner, from Walford Iowa, therefore advanced to her first GISBT match play finals, where she finished in 6th place, raking in a \$110 scholarship.

MAGNUSON CAPTURES 2nd TOUR WIN IN A ROW

MAGNUSON MAKES IT 2 IN A ROW

For the 2nd straight month, southpaw Kevin Magnuson caught fire in match play and pulled away from his counterparts to earn a GISBT championship. The 2-handed southpaw from Morgan Hill, California closed match play with 6 straight wins on the strength of all 6 games being over 240, as he swept both of this season's Waterloo tour stops.

Magnuson qualified in 5th place, earning a spot in his 2nd GISBT match play finals. This month's effort was almost an identical repeat of last month's performance when he won his first tour crown. For his 15 tournament games, he averaged a whopping 238.53 to earn the win. He took home the \$425 scholarship as well as the championship plaque. Congratulations, Kevin!

PAST CHAMP PIET CLAIMS RUNNER-UP

Aidan Piet – one of 3 past champions in this month's boy's finals field, took home runner-up honors. The Meridian, Idaho native was in fine form and his 2nd place finish netted him a \$300 payday. Piet emerged from a 4-player pack that was separated by just 70 pins to earn the runner-up spot.

WEISMAN-WOODS 3rd IN TOUR DEBUT

Joe Weiseman-Woods made his GISBT tour a successful one. The 2-hander from Minneapolis turned in a consistent showing, and eventually finished in 3rd place, taking home the \$275 scholarship. He appears to have a bright future on tour.

SIDERS LEADS QUALIFYING, TAKES 4th

Kendric Siders has become one of the most dependable players on the GISBT circuit. Over the past 2 seasons, the right-hander from Eagle River, Alaska, has qualified for 7 match play finals in 9 tournament appearances. This month, the reigning Bowler of the Year took home a \$250 prize for his 4th place finish.

STEEN FIRES 802 ON WAY TO FINISHING 5th

Rush Steen began his day in prime form, opening with games of 266, 279 and 257 for a splashy 802 series, and that propelled him into his first-ever GISBT match play finals. Competing in front of his hometown crows, the promising 15-year-old raked in a \$225 scholarship for his 5th place finish. Steen is another young phenom that appears to have a very successful future ahead of him.

YOUNG TAKES 6th

William Young was this month's 6th place finisher. Young – a right-hander from Summerville, South Carolina, captured a \$200 award for his performance – the 5th match play finals appearance of his tour career.

RICHARDS PLACES 7th

Devin Richards rolled into the 2nd match play finals of his career at this month's tour stop, and it resulted in a 7th place finish. The Fort Myers, Florida resident with the smooth swing took home a \$175 scholarship.

ALEXANDER 8th IN TOUR DEBUT

Keegan Alexander rounded out this month's boy's finals field. The talented right-hander from Killeen, Texas was making his GISBT debut, and it resulted in an 8th place finish. Alexander qualified in 3rd place but struggled through the match play portion; he took home a \$150 scholarship for his day's work.
