- Ceremonial center- Chichen Itza
- Built pyramids and temples
- Religion
  - a. Polytheistic
  - b. Religious text: Popul Vuh explains story of creation
  - c. Quetzalcoatl: god who will return and rule
  - d. Human sacrifice

### III Warfare

- Religious rituals before battles
- Kings and nobles fight with soldiers
- Wanted slaves, not territory for farming
- Had no large animals

### IV Achievements

- Advanced farming
- Cotton and maize
- Pyramids and ball-courts for religious purposes
- Excellent mathematicians (concept of zero)
- Hieroglyphics
- 18 month 20 day calendar (lunar and solar calendars

## V Collapse

- Late 800-900 Mayans vanished
- Believed to be:
  - 1. disease
  - 2. warfare
  - 3. drought
  - 4. natural disaster
- 900s Toltec take over Central Mexico
- 1200 collapse to Aztecs
