Week 2: Surge start with two ties

The Island Surge started their regular season with a pair of ties on home ice against the Meadow Ridge Moose.

The two South Coast Women's Hockey League teams played to a 2-2 tie Saturday night at the Panorama Rec Centre in North Saanich, then skated to scoreless draw Sunday morning in Esquimalt.

Madeline Čockrill scored twice for the Moose in Saturday's game, each goal giving the visitors a one-goal lead. The Surge responded with goals from Bailey Kasum and Mary Claire Genau.

Meadow Ridge outshot the Surge 37-23, and went onefor-four on the powerplay.

Alex Garb blocked 21 of 23 shots in the Moose net, which did not take a penalty in the game.

Meadow Ridge fired 44 shots at the Surge goal, but were unable to get a puck past Megan Buchanan who made 79 saves over the two games, allowing just two goals and earning her second shutout in two SCWHL seasons.

Garb, making just her fifth SCWHL start, picked up her first-ever shutout by making 21 saves.

The South Fraser TNT moved into second place with a pair of wins in Week 2.

Jaime Jacquard-Sowa scored the winning goal with eight minutes remaining then added an insurance tally with two minutes to go to lift South Fraser to a 3-1 win over the North Shore Rebels Thursday night at New Westminster's Moody Park Arena. Emily Grainger assisted on both goals, and Sarah Forster netted the first goal of the game for the TNT. Nicole Charlton opened the scoring for the Rebels, who lost their first game of the season despite firing 52 shots at the TNT goal. South Fraser goalie Jennifer Price stopped all but one shot.

The TNT then upset the defending league and provin-

cial champion Fraser Valley Jets 3-1 Saturday afternoon at Planet Ice – Delta.

Price was again a standout in the South Fraser goal, stopping 40 of 41 shots. Taralynn Suzuki opened the scoring for the TNT, and Hayley Voytechek added a winning goal and an insurance goal.

Rachel Budden scored for the Jets, who went one-for-six on the powerplay and killed off their only shorthanded situation.

In the only other game of

Week 2, Sienna Cooke stopped 29 of 30 shots to allow the TWU Spartans to come from behind for a 2-1 win over the Richmond Devils.

After two scoreless periods, the Devils went ahead with just five minutes remaining on Tamara Wong's first goal of the season.

The Spartans rallied for the win when Alura Duguay assisted on the tying goal from Jessica Golz with 2:17 to go, and the winner from Adriene Duguay with 27 seconds remaining.

Three Stars of the Week

First Star: Jaime Jacquard-Sowa **(South Fraser TNT)** Two goals from the former RPI Engineer of the NCAA capped a South Fraser TNT come-from-behind win over the North Shore Rebels.

Jacquard-Sowa netted the game-winner with eight minutes remaining, then added an insurance goal with just 2:23 left on the clock.

Second Star: Megan Buchanan (Island Surge)

Island Surge netminder Megan Buchanan had a save percentage of .975, helping her team to a pair of ties against the visiting Meadow Ridge Moose.

Buchanan made 35 saves in a 2-2 tie Saturday night, then earned her first shutout of the season Sunday morning by blocking 44 shots in a scoreless draw.

Third Star: Hayley Voytechek (South Fraser TNT)

Hayley Voytechek netted her first two goals of the season, helping the South Fraser TNT to a 3-1 win over the defending provincial champion Fraser Valley Jets.

The former UBC Thunderbird scored the winning goal midway through the second period, and added an insurance tally with 10 minutes left in the game.
