

Stay Focused.

I came across a post on Facebook a week or so ago by a favorite Christian lady I truly admire, Kelli Vance. Her and her husband, Dr. Charles Vance minister in Barbersville, WVA. Her testimony is amazing and you can't help but believe in second chances, freedom from anything that has its chains about you and miracles. This godly lady has overcome more than many of us put together. Kelli has this knack, as I like to call it, for taking the simplest, the most mundane, and even the silliest of daily events/tasks and applying it to our walk with God. On this particular day, Kelli wrote about something all of us are faced with these days thanks to our hectic lives... **staying focused**. Here's her post:

"Admission: Every time we go in Walmart Charles has to hold my hand to the buggy because I get so easily distracted by all the things around me to look at. If I'm by myself I seriously can spend two hours in there for a list of five things. It's crazy! My focus gets off of what I need to accomplish and onto everything around me. As I was just sitting here in prayer this morning I thought about how many distractions the enemy brings all around us for us to look at, or consider. He'll do his best to distract us with negative situations, bad circumstance, and bad reports in attempts to pull our focus off of the promise and onto the problem.

2 Corinthians 5:7 says that we walk by faith and not by sight. Getting distracted by everything that touches us emotionally can jeopardize what we are able to receive by faith. My husband says it like this, "*Where your focus goes, the power flows*". You actually give power to what you focus on. If you get distracted by negative things and focus on them too long you'll end up energizing them and making them greater than what they already are. So I want to encourage you today to stay focused on where God is leading you, what God says about you, what God says you can have, and what God says you can be. When you do, your faith will magnify the promise and give more life to it. So don't get distracted by the enemy's lie. You were created to have every good and perfect gift that comes from the Father. Stay focused, stay in faith, and get ready to receive your promise!"
