**AN ORDINANCE TO AMEND CHAPTER 109 OF THE HAMPTON
TOWNSHIP CODE BEING THE STORMWATER CONTROL
ORDINANCE WITH RESPECT TO REQUIREMENTS FOR
STORMWATER CONTROL**

ORDINANCE NO. 2016-04

NOW THEREFORE BE IT ORDAINED by the Township of Hampton that Chapter 109 of the Hampton Township Code being the Stormwater Control Chapter shall be and is hereby amended as follows:

Section One

Section 109-6 is hereby amended to read as follows: "The definition of the term "MAJOR DEVELOPMENT" is hereby amended to read as follows: Any development that provides for ultimately disturbing one or more acres of land or a cumulative increase in the impervious surface by one acre or more. Disturbance for the purpose of this Rule is the placement of impervious surface or exposure and/or movement of soil or bed rock or clearing, cutting or removing of vegetation."

Section Two

Section 109-11 Stormwater Run-off Quality Standards Section A is hereby amended to read as follows: "Stormwater management measures shall be designed to reduce the post-construction load of total suspended solids (TSS) in stormwater run-off by 80% of the anticipated load from the developed site, expressed as an annual average. Stormwater management measures shall only be required for water quality control if an additional one acre of impervious surface is being proposed on a development site. The requirement to reduce TSS does not apply to any stormwater runoff in a discharge regulated under a numeric effluent limitation for TSS imposed under the New Jersey Pollution Discharge Elimination System (NJPDES rules, N.J.A.C. 7:14A, or in a discharge specifically exempt under a NJPDES permit from this requirement. The water quality design storm

is 1.25 inches of rainfall in two hours. Water quality calculations shall take into account the distribution of rain from the water quality design storm, as reflected in Table 1. The calculation of the volume of runoff may take into account the implementation of nonstructural and structural stormwater management measures.

Section Three

Should any section, paragraph, sentence, clause or phrase of this Ordinance be declared unconstitutional or invalid for any reason by any Court of competent jurisdiction, such provision(s) shall be deemed severable and the remaining portions of this Ordinance shall remain in full force and effect.

Section Four

All Ordinances or parts of Ordinances or Resolutions that are inconsistent with the provisions of this Ordinance are repealed to the extent of such inconsistency.

Section Five

The Township Clerk is directed to give notice at least ten days prior to the hearing on the adoption of this Ordinance to the County Planning Board and to all others entitled pursuant to the Provisions of N.J.S.A. 40:55D-15. Upon the adoption of this Ordinance, after public hearing, the Township Clerk is further directed to publish notice of the passage and to file a copy of this Ordinance, as finally adopted, with the Sussex County Planning Board, as required by N.J.S.A. 40:55D-16.

Section Six


This Ordinance shall take effect after publication and passage according to law.
