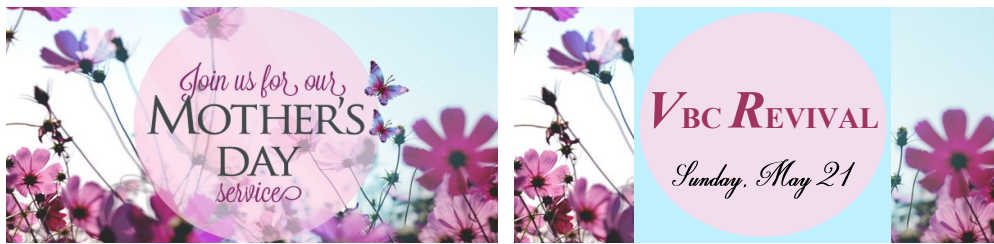


KIDZ KAMP \$50 DEPOSITS ARE DUE!
