John 11:25: Jesus said to Martha, "I am the resurrection and the life. He who believes in me will live, even though he dies; and whoever lives and believes in me will never die."

The Season of Lent is here.

It seems hard to believe that it can be the time for Lent, when it feels as if we have just finished putting away all our Christmas decorations, and, perhaps, finished paying some of the extra expenses incurred during the Christmas holiday season.

During Lent, we walk with Jesus as his ministry leads him to the Cross at Golgotha (which means The Place of the Skull).

Jesus is mocked, beaten, spit upon and crucified on the Cross.

This man, who had never sinned, was crucified for <u>our</u> sins. This man, who loved us as no one will ever be able to love us, became the Sacrificial Lamb so we might have eternal life.

REDNER'S REGISTER TAPES

Did you know that Redner's Warehouse Markets gives 1% of purchases back to the Women of the ELCA? This one percent can really add up! And the monies goes to good things like the Mission Trip, VFW, Berk's Women in Crisis, just to name a few.

In order for Redner's to count the receipt (a.k.a. register tape), it has to be the ENTIRE receipt, and it has to have a "save-a-tape" number on it. How do you insure this? Well, you must use your pump perks card or save-a-tape card at the checkout. Then, just drop the ENTIRE receipt in the box at the ushers station in the narthex. DO NOT cut the bottom off. We only get credit for COMPLETE tapes! Also, please be sure to turn your tapes in in a timely manner, as Redner's will not accept any over three years old.
