A WARM WELCOME FOR ALL

Welcome to the Willette church of Christ, where you will find the Bible as our only rule for faith and practice. We seek to speak where the Bible speaks and to be silent where the Bible is silent. We want to call Bible things by Bible names and do Bible things in Bible ways.

Jesus said, "Go ye therefore, and teach all nations, baptizing them in the name of the Father, and of the Son, and of the Holy Ghost" (Matthew 28:18-20). Our evangelistic efforts include several local and foreign mission works listed on the back of this bulletin. The home congregation is the most important work. Therefore, every month, we spend time door knocking, visiting, and helping our local community. We have a large benevolent building that operates every Tuesday from 8:30-12:30, which offers free clothes and other items to anyone in need. Our primary foreign work is found in Andhra Pradesh, India, where Brother *Jack Honeycutt* serves as our full time mission coordinator. We are also blessed to have a full time prison ministry with services conducted each Sunday from 1:00-3:00. Brother *Tim McHenry* is our regular preacher. In addition to preaching, he teaches classes and is involved in many works here at Willette. Our associate preachers *Mark West* and *Ben Smith* preach, teach classes, minister in the nursing home, coordinate our visitation teams, and work with our Bible camp and youth in general. In addition, we have a radio program on 102.1 FM that airs each weekday around 12:15.

We are a Bible centered, mission minded, and family oriented church. We hope you will enjoy our fellowship. Thank you for coming, and please return at every opportunity.

Tidings from Timothy

Having recently preached to you on the Subject of faith, I feel it is a good time to move on to repentance. Many are scared about repentance, but it just means change. In the Bible, this is change for the better. Repentance is that hard, unseen thing that most feel uncomfortable talking about but Jesus made it plain it is necessary.

Meals on Wheels: You are doing great, don't forget that we have a lot of eager beavers so if you want to help you have to show somewhat early.

India Work: The team has been working in Rampachodavaram and have 315 baptisms with 55 villages visited. One more week to go!

Work Lists: There are now some more of these out front, so if you want to expand your service, pick one up.

Digging Deeper: This class will resume for the new year on the 27th with a class Sunday at 3:30pm at the church building (especially good for those who can't make the Tuesday night or want to come and see what it is all about) and then at the Drapers on Tuesday the 29th.

Family Bible Hour: This will start February 3rd at 5:15. **During Family Bible Hour we will not have pew packer class.** Pew Packer will resume after FBH ends in March. We WILL have Pew Packer tonight.

Singing Night: Don't forget to come with your voice prepared to sing His praises! This is tonight at 6pm.

Tim's Schedule

Some may wonder about the best time to get in touch with me. Others may want to know basically when I am around Willette and when I am generally "out." Whatever your interest (if you have any interest in my whereabouts ☺) here are my regular activities: (A word about reaching me) On any given day, it may be hard to reach me. This is because 1. Things come up with members that may temporarily call me away or 2. I don't have cell service in the place where I am. In particular, I DO NOT generally have cell service with any reliability (it will drop the call or not even ring) while I am at home or in the church building. Either no. for the church building will ring the office now, and our home phone is

6156997311, notice that the prefix is all that is different from my cell phone of 6156557311. Also, I check the church email each day, so you can reach me that way if it is not too urgent. I CAN generally get texts in most places in Willette, unless I have headed "down the hill" if you know what I mean. In that case the text may be received a few minutes or even a couple hours later.

Sunday: well, you know what is going on this day. I am generally preaching the Nursing Home service on the 3rd Sunday and just any given Sunday Connie or I or both of us may be at the Jail in the afternoon.

Monday: In the Winter, meals on wheels takes up a portion of Monday morning into lunch time. Before that I am often making radio programs so Monday is hard to get me before the afternoon. In fact, there may be people or situations I need to follow up on from Sunday, so Monday is hard to catch me in the office, period.

Tuesday: I am around the building most of the day. In the morning I am here helping with the Benevolent Building and eating donuts. When William is through with me and I have had lunch I go back to the building and can be found until 4 or 5pm in the office, when I go out to make a few visits.

Wednesday: I am here most of the day as well. An exception is the 3rd Wednesday when I go visiting in the afternoon at the Nursing Home. I find this is an excellent time to get to know them better, minister to them, and eat cake. It is your fault for me doing that since you make such good cakes. Other than that, I am usually here at the building getting ready for Midweek study. I also may be making some radio programs or sermon practicing in the Auditorium.

Thursday: I may be gone most of the day on hospital/shut-in visitation. In the evenings I make evangelistic visits.

Friday: I am working on the bulletin and prayer list, or making visits I may not have gotten to on Thursday (depending on when an Elder is available to visit with me). Finalizing plans for Sunday lessons.

Saturday: family time or evangelistic visits in the community.

Of course, any of these days can be interrupted by baptisms, funerals, or weddings.

I hope this has been of some help and I want you to know that I am not a slave to routine and am always open to doing what is needed at the moment, give me a call or visit.
